Kiersten Enemark from Shaw was in my office today talking about Pink Shirt Day and Pink Shirt Promise. Apparently she talked to PCC at the Premier's Women's event about Shaw's involvement in #pinkshirtpromise Feb 9-24 and the Premier expressed interest. I understand Kiersten also talked with MLA Tegart and there was preliminary interest in getting something organized with MLA's. Shaw is available to come to the Legislature any time between Feb 9 – 24 and film MLA's in pink shirts to talk about their promises and topics pertaining to anti-bullying – in a build up to Pink Shirt Day. Jane - thanks for speaking with me today about all things anti bullying.

As a quick review:

- For February 24th (Pink Shirt Day) have Tad Milmine, founder of Bullying Ends Here, as a guest speaker on the Leg steps. My client (Dominion Lending the National Sponsor for BEH) already has him in the Lower Mainland for the 22nd and 23rd. I could drive Tad from Vancouver to Victoria for the day.
- As background, Tad is a former BC RCMP officer now working for the Calgary police. He quit the RCMP when they told him to stop with his anti bullying talks. Tad started BEH in 2012 in BC and uses his own time and often money to spread his anti bullying story and message.
- Love to see how Erase Bullying can have a more formal relationship with BEH and I Am Someone by providing some funding and resource support. Tad from BEH spoke to 90,000 people across Canada in 2015 so he has the educational piece down pat. IAS has a technology component which Tad could promote during his talks. Erase has the reach, online reporting tool and funding to help offset some expenses and thus grow the anti bullying message reach.
- An additional thought for the 24th would be (as a surprise) to award Tad with a Medal of Good Citizenship. He is deserving and awarding him this honour brings more attention to anti bullying as well as to the Medal program.
