- The British Columbia Medal of Good Citizenship Selection Committee was not designated as a public body under Schedule 2 of FOIPPA and was therefore not subject to the Act at the time the requests were made.
- IGRS advised that responsive records are treated separately from IGRS records and are not in their custody or control.

- On July 11, 2016 The Medal of Good Citizenship Selection Committee was made a public body when it was added to Schedule 2 of FOIPPA by Ministerial Order. IGRS requested IAO redraft the applicant response letter in order to note this change.
- OOP-2016-62073 was directed to GCPE and FIN. Those requests are currently being processed by IAO.
