Hi all: Media lines below from RCMP:

- The RCMP in British Columbia have heard through community and individual complainants about concerns around fentanyl contaminated marijuana and issued localized warnings about the possibility. We have even had individuals present with opioid overdose symptoms that have claimed they have only consumed marijuana. However, we have never seized or confirmed via chemical analysis any marijuana laced with or contaminated with fentanyl.
- We remain concerned over the possibility of cross contamination given the heightened presence of fentanyl in the Canadian illicit drug market. And we ask everyone to remain vigilant, know the symptoms and call 9-1-1 for medical assistance should you suspect someone you know is experiencing an overdose.

Hi Minister.

Kristy and I have been working on this one together this morning. This just came in from PSSG, so wanted to make sure you are aware before you call any of the outlets... This is now the Vancouver Police Department messaging this morning in response to the media, questioning a previous comment from a few months back from one of their

spokespeople that indicated they had a seizure of marijuana laced with fentanyl (article is in one of the links below that Kristy sent):

"This is a constant battle to try and keep this information accurate. That comment by Sandra may have been the belief at the time based on the information she was provided, but it has shown not to be the case and we continue to correct any misinformation. The VPD have made fentanyl seizures where there are other drugs like cocaine, heroin, meth, and marijuana present. I suspect the Coroner would likely say that they have cases where individuals who have died from an overdose have fentanyl in their system along with other drugs like cocaine, heroin, meth, and marijuana, but of course there is no way to determine how those drugs entered their system. I can't speak for other police departments and I can't say that fentanyl has not, is not or couldn't be placed in marijuana, but I can tell you that the VPD has not seized marijuana that has been tested and shown that it has been laced with fentanyl."

Dr. Daly is standing by her comments in the media, that they are unaware of any evidence of fentanyl-laced marijuana. Clayton Pecknold has advised the only case they're aware of is the Masset notice. He notes: "We don't have confirmation that the marijuana tested positive. Beyond this there is the same anecdote and street info you will be aware of."

Suggested added messaging:

We rely on the information we're given by first responders and law enforcement. Clearly, from the examples we've provided to media (per links below), we have been told there are cases of pot contaminated with fentanyl.

There is no official confirmation of any cases to date, however there have been warnings by police to be cautious of contamination in any drug, including marijuana, and other anecdotal stories of fentanyl being found in marijuana.

There is the occasional report of overdoses where people reported taking marijuana, but responded to naloxone. In such a situation, we would suspect an opioid was involved, but testing hasn't been conducted in any case that we are aware of at this time.

It can be difficult to confirm whether an exposure was from marijuana, as people may be less comfortable admitting to using other types of drugs.

The bottom line is that overdoses don't discriminate and anyone using any drug needs to be careful – any drug can contain fentanyl.

As the federal government moves towards legalization of cannabis, our focus remains to be the health and safety of British Columbians.

The elements to cannabis legalization that we are most concerned about are:

- young people should not have access to cannabis before they are of age;
- o consumers are getting a product that they expect;
- o the criminal element is kept out and that a strategy is in place to deal with the influx of dispensaries.

Currently in Canada, the only legal commercial source of safe, quality-controlled medical cannabis for purchase is via registered mail from one of 35 producers licensed by Health Canada.
