So there are two steps from our perspective, one is that I am working with the Premier to get her sign off on an idea for exactly how she can take part — to be totally honest, she wasn't super keen about just the straight up singing — and then if she's good with it, and you are good with it, we'll find a time to actually shoot it. For your reference, here were the two possible ideas that we came up with, not sure if either works from your perspective? I've just copied and pasted below what we sent her. Totally open if you have an alternative to these. And just out of curiosity, who else is taking part? S.

1) Rather than a long segment singing the entire song, you and Tamara in the car, singing along to a song the radio, Tamara realizes what your singing actually sounds like and turns off the radio so that it's just you, Tamara says something like, "how about we just lip sync the rest?" You have some sort of funny self deprecating line in response... maybe something about the planned karaoke party fundraiser. This could be a good funny bit at the very end of the segment when they've already had some singers up on screen. 2) Again, rather than a long segment, this could be a series of short snippets interspersed throughout the videos of other people singing. Basically you and Tamara discussing (and not agreeing on) what song you want to sing. All of your suggestions aren't actually real songs... but politically appropriate variations such as you wants to sing L-N-G by AC/DC.... "L-N-G, lots of jobs... L-N-G, no more debt", but she points out that it's actually T-N-T by AC/DC, Then the next one perhaps Stand by your Premier, instead of Stand by your Man, things like that. Finally at the end she gets frustrated and says is there anything non-musical that we can listen to instead, you suggest re-listening to the 2013 Election Night coverage.
