Yesterday's Throne Speech now challenges the resolve of the opposition parties, who must now explain why they oppose measures - each and every one, that widely benefit BCers.

Partisan politics and negative campaigning are often motivated by very strong negative feelings of anger and fear regarding the other side who are seen as the adversary. These feelings are often vented not in a very positive way, but through negative behaviour focused on discrediting and destroying the opponent.
