~1155 Cabinet Operations Staff arrive at Government House and set-up the

boutonnieres and documents.

1158 Ms. Elizabeth MacMillan, Deputy Cabinet Secretary, arrives at Government House to meet with Mr. Jerymy Brownridge. 1200 Mr. Brownridge and Ms. MacMillan lead a walk-through/briefing for the ceremony. 1205 HADC, Lieutenant-Commander Simon Brown, arrives at Government House and is briefed by Mr. Brownridge. 1220 Mr. Don Craig, Photographer, arrives at Government House to set up for official group photo in the Foyer in front of the fireplace. 1230 The doors to Government House open. Guests and Ministers-Designate begin arriving at Government House on a bus and in some private vehicles. They enter through the front door and proceed to the Drawing Room. Ministers-Designate are escorted to the Drawing Room by Cabinet Operations Staff where they are given their boutonnieres and they sign the necessary forms. Her Honour and Mr. Brownridge proceed to Her Honour's Office. Ms. MacMillan proceeds to Her Honour's Office to have documents signed by Her Honour. 1250 The Premier arrive at Government House The Premier is escorted to Her Honour's office by Mr. Brownridge Her Honour, the Premier and Ms. McMillan review Oath Book, Oath Forms, and appointment forms in Her Honour's Office. Her Honour signs the documents. 1252 Mr. Brownridge goes to the podium in the Drawing Room and briefs the Ministers-Designate on the order of the Ceremony and process for taking of the Oaths (swear or affirm). 1255 The Media are escorted into position in the Drawing Room. 1259 Ms. McMillan, Deputy Cabinet Secretary, places the Oath Book on the signing table and takes her seat. 1300 Once the HADC is given the signal, the HADC escorts Her Honour, the Premier, and the Cabinet Secretary to the Foyer.

The HADC forms the procession in the Foyer outside of the Drawing Room:

1301 Mr. Brownridge proceeds to the podium, welcomes the guests, provides a brief description of the Ceremony and its significance.

"GOOD MORNING LADIES AND GENTLEMEN. WELCOME TO GOVERNMENT HOUSE.

MY NAME IS JERYYMY BROWNRIDGE AND I AM THE PRIVATE SECRETARY TO THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF BRITISH COLUMBIA.

ON BEHALF OF HER HONOUR, THE HONOURABLE JUDITH GUICHON, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF BRITISH COLUMBIA, AND THE HONORUABLE CHRISTY CLARK, PREMIER OF BRITISH COLUMBIA, WELCOME TO THIS CEREMONY DURING WHICH NEW MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL OF THE GOVERNMENT OF BRITISH COLUMBIA WILL BE FORMALLY INSTALLED IN OFFICE.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, PLEASE RISE FOR THE ARRIVAL OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR AND THE PREMIER."

Her Honour and the Premier enter the Drawing Room and take their places beside the podium.

Mr. Brownridge asks the guests to be seated and calls on Her Honour to give her remarks.

Her Honour's remarks. (1 minutes)

1302 Mr. Brownridge thanks Her Honour and asks Her Honour to administer the Oaths to the Premier.

"THANK YOU YOUR HONOUR, I WOULD CALL UPON YOU TO ADMINISTER THE OATHS TO THE PREMIER"

HADC hands the text of the Oaths to Her Honour.

Her Honour administers the Oaths to the Premier.

### The Premier:

- · Oath of Office;
- Oath of Allegiance;
- Oath of Confidentiality.

The Premier repeats each sentence after Her Honour.

Her Honour then declares the Premier... "CHRISTY CLARK DULY SWORN AND APPOINTED PRESIDENT OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL AND PREMIER OF BRITISH COLUMBIA."

Her Honour and Premier Clark proceed to the signing table. Cabinet Secretary takes the bible from the Premier.

The Premier signs the Oath Book. (red dot where Premier signs) Photograph.

Her Honour rises and shakes hands with the Honourable Christy Clark, Premier of British Columbia.

The Premier proceeds to position behind lectern.

Her Honour moves to the centre.

Mr. Brownridge says:

"THANK YOU, YOUR HONOUR. LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, AS YOU ARE AWARE, APPOINTMENTS TO THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL ARE MADE BY HER HONOUR UPON THE ADVICE OF THE PREMIER.

THIS MORNING, HER HONOUR WILL ADMINISTER THE OATHS OF ALLEGIANCE, OF OFFICE AND OF CONFIDENTIALITY. I WILL THEN ANNOUNCE THE MINISTERS AND THEIR RESPECTIVE PORTFOLIOS, FOLLOWING WHICH THE MINISTERS WILL COME FORWARD AND SIGN THE OATH BOOK."

Mr. Brownridge calls the Ministers-Designate to rise and calls on Her Honour to administer the Oaths:

"MINISTERS-DESIGNATE PLEASE STAND AND HER HONOUR THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR WILL ADMINSTER THE OATHS.

(Wait until the Ministers-Designate are standing, he then calls Her Honour.)

YOUR HONOUR..."

The HADC presents Her Honour with the text.

### Her Honour administers the Oaths to the Ministers-Designate:

- Oath of Office;
- Oath Allegiance;
- Oath of Confidentiality.

The Ministers-Designate repeat each sentence after Her Honour.

At the end, Her Honour then declares THE MINISTERS-DESIGNATE, "...
DULY SWORN/AFFIRMED AND A MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL OF
BRITISH COLUMBIA."

Following the Oaths to Ministers, Mr. Brownridge indicates that:

Mr. Brownridge announces the portfolio of each Minister as they come forward to sign the oath book.

Each member is directed by the Cabinet Secretary to the desk to sign the Oath Book. (Photographer takes photo of each person signing documents.)

Members are called forward to the signing table, they sign the book, shake hands with Her Honour, move to Premier and shake hands and return to their seat, except for the Attorney General who shakes hands and stays at the signing table to receive the Great Seal.

Mr. Brownridge requests the Attorney General to receive custody of the Great Seal of British Columbia from the Lieutenant Governor. The Attorney General and Her Honour stand.

Mr. Brownridge says:

"YOUR HONOUR, I NOW REQUEST THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND ATTORNEY GENERAL TO RECEIVE FROM YOU, ON BEHALF OF THE CROWN, THE GREAT SEAL OF BRITISH COLUMBIA".

Her Honour says:

"TO THE SAFE CUSTODY OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, I COMMIT THE GREAT SEAL OF THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA.

Her Honour hands the Great Seal to the Attorney General. (Photograph)

Attorney General returns to her position with the Great Seal.

Mr. Brownridge says:

"LADIES AND GENTLEMAN, PREMIER CHRISTY CLARK AND THE NEW EXECUTIVE COUNCIL OF THE PROVICE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA"

Mr. Brownridge thanks everyone and announces the departure of the Official Party.

"YOUR HONOUR, PREMIER, LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, THIS CONCLUDES THE CEREMONY. WOULD YOU PLEASE STAND FOR THE DEPARTURE OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF BRITISH COLUMBIA AND THE EXCECUTIVE COUNCIL.

GOOD AFTERNOON, LADIES AND GENTLEMEN. MY NAME IS HERB LEROY. I AM PRIVATE SECRETARY TO HIS HONOUR, THE HONOURABLE STEVEN POINT, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF BRITISH COLUMBIA, AND ON BEHALF OF HIS HONOUR AND PREMIER DESIGNATE CHRISTY CLARK – WELCOME TO THIS CEREMONY WHEREIN THE PREMIER, AND THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, WILL BE FORMALLY INSTALLED INTO OFFICE.

THESE PROCEEDINGS ARE RICH IN TRADITION OF OUR CONSTITUTIONAL MONARCHY.

IN EACH OF OUR PROVINCES, THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR EXERCISES THE AUTHORITY OF THE CROWN, AND IN THE NAME OF HER MAJESTY GIVES FORMAL APPROVAL TO LAWS ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY, THE ADMINISTRATION OF WHICH IS CARRIED OUT IN THE NAME OF THE QUEEN BY THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL - THE CABINET – OF WHICH THE PREMIER IS PRESIDENT.

WITHIN CANADA'S PROVINCIAL CONSTITUTIONAL STRUCTURE, THE PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR IS TO ENSURE THAT THERE IS ALWAYS A GOVERNMENT IN OFFICE, AND THAT BASIC PRINCIPLES OF RESPONSBILE GOVERNANCE ARE RESPECTED.

AND AS REPRESENTATIVE OF THE QUEEN, THE LIEUTEANT GOVERNOR WILL NOW INSTALL THE NEW GOVERNMENT. FIRSTLY, HIS HONOUR WILL ADMINISTER THE OATHS OF ALLEGIANCE, OF OFFICE, AND OF CONFIDENTIALITY TO PREMIER DESIGNATE CLARK AS FIRST MINISTER, PREMIER OF BRITISH COLUMBIA, AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL.

AND THEN UPON PREMIER CLARK'S RECOMMENDATION, HIS HONOUR WILL INSTALL THE MEMBERS SELECTED FOR THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL BY ADMINISTERING THE SAME OATHS, AFTER WHICH PREMIER CLARK WILL ANNOUNCE THEIR PORTFOLIOS.

1:05 p.m.

Herb LeRoy asks guests to rise and remain standing for the entrance of Ministers-designate followed by the entrance of the Premier-designate and the Lieutenant Governor.



His Honour shakes hands with the new Premier. (photo)

His Honour moves to the table at stage right. Premier Clark follows.

His Honour moves to the right of the table to witness the signing.

The Premier sits and signs the Oath Book and Oath Forms.

His Honour sits and signs the two official documents.

His Honour rises and shakes hands with the Honourable Christy Clark, Premier of British Columbia.

Marc-André places Premier's notes on the lectern.

Premier proceeds to position behind lectern.

GOOD AFTERNOON. LADIES AND GENTLEMEN. MY NAME IS HERB LEROY. I AM PRIVATE SECRETARY TO HIS HONOUR, THE HONOURABLE STEPHEN L. POINT, OBC, LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR OF BRITISH COLUMBIA, AND ON BEHALF OF HIS HONOUR, HER HONOUR MRS. GWENDOLYN POINT, PREMIER DESIGNATE CLARK (AND FAMILY?) – WELCOME TO THIS CEREMONY WHEREIN THE PREMIER AND THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL WILL BE FORMALLY INSTALLED INTO OFFICE.

THESE PROCEEDINGS ARE RICH IN THE TRADITION OF OUR CONSTITUTIONAL MONARCHY, STARTING FROM THE MAGNA CARTA, IN 1215, WHEN KING JOHN AGREED TO SHARE AUTHORITY WITH HIS PEOPLE. AND TODAY, WHILE CONSTITUTIONAL AUTHORITY CONTINUES TO BE VESTED IN THE CROWN, HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN OF CANADA AND HER REPRESENTATIVES ACT UPON THE ADVICE, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE PEOPLE, OF THEIR ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES.

IN EACH OF OUR PROVINCES, THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR EXERCISES THE AUTHORITY OF THE CROWN, AND IN THE NAME OF HER MAJESTY GIVES FORMAL APPROVAL TO LAWS ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY, THE <u>ADMINISTRATION</u> OF WHICH IS CARRIED OUT IN THE NAME OF THE QUEEN BY THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL - THE CABINET – OF WHICH THE PREMIER IS PRESIDENT.

IN TURN THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, COLLECTIVELY FORMULATES GOVERNMENT POLICIES AND PRIORITIES, AND, UPON THE APPROVAL OF THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR AS PRESCRIBED BY LAW, ISSUES EXECUTIVE ORDERS AND MAKES REGULATIONS FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT.

WITHIN CANADA'S PROVINCIAL CONSTITUTIONAL STRUCTURE, THE PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY OF THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR IS TO ENSURE THAT THERE ALWAYS IS A GOVERNMENT IN OFFICE, AND THAT THE BASIC PRINCIPLES OF RESPONSIBLE GOVERNANCE - ONE THAT HAS THE VOTE OF THE MAJORITY OF MLAS - ARE RESPECTED.

HOWEVER, THOSE ELECTED TO GOVERN DO NOT POSSESS <u>ABSOLUTE</u> AUTHORITY BECAUSE THEY ARE ACCOUNTABLE IN THE EXERCISE OF THEIR OFFICES TO THE PEOPLE AS EMBODIED IN THE INSTITUTION OF THE CROWN.

FOLLOWING THE RESIGNATION OF PREMIER GORDON CAMPBELL AND THE ELECTION OF CHRISTY CLARK TO LEAD THE BC LIBERAL PARTY - HIS HONOUR INVITED PREMIER-DESIGNATE CLARK - AS LEADER OF THE PARTY HOLDING THE MAJORITY OF SEATS IN THE LEGISLATURE - TO FORM A GOVERNMENT – EFFECTIVE AT THIS INSTALLATION -

AND AS REPRESENTATIVE OF THE QUEEN, THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR WILL NOW INSTALL THE NEW GOVERNMENT. FIRSTLY, HIS HONOUR WILL ADMINISTER THE OATHS OF ALLEGIANCE, OF OFFICE, AND OF CONFIDENTIALITY TO PREMIER-DESIGNATE CLARK TO BECOME FIRST MINISTER, PREMIER OF BRITISH COLUMBIA, AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL.

AND THEN UPON PREMIER CLARK'S RECOMMENDATION, HIS HONOUR WILL INSTALL THE MEMBERS SELECTED FOR THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL BY ADMINISTERING THE SAME OATHS, AFTER WHICH PREMIER CLARK WILL ANNOUNCE THEIR PORTFOLIOS.


