On behalf of Imperial Tobacco Canada, I have been asked to inquire about the interest of the Office of the Premier in a briefing on the illegal tobacco situation in British Columbia, following up on the attached letter which details the links between illegal tobacco and the opioid epidemic.

Some alarming trends have come to light of late, all of which suggest the illegal trade is picking up considerably. New data from next door in Alberta also suggests an unprecedented spike in illegal tobacco there.

By way of background, I have also attached an overview of the illegal tobacco problem in Canada.

Sebastien Charbonneau, Director of Government and Regulatory Affairs for Imperial, is in BC for other business on August 14 and 15. Based on his current flight plan, he is free the afternoon of the 14<sup>th</sup> and the morning of the 15<sup>th</sup>. He could be in Vancouver or Victoria as required.
