

Dear friends.

Questions have arisen about the appropriate approach to participation in celebrations of Taiwan's National Day by members of the government, particularly ministers. (This concern can arise in many other contexts, which I hope to deal with in a subsequent note.) These concerns are generally not an issue for MLAs not in cabinet or in opposition parties.

After some consultation with the Intergovernmental Relations Secretariat I'm writing to suggest the following approach.

First of all, some context:

- Our government embraces newcomer and immigrant communities, celebrates their contributions to the life of the province and looks forward to strengthening ties between them and our government;
- We are proud that members of diverse communities are winning election to the Legislature and moving into leadership positions, including in cabinet;
- Our government generally does not take positions on matters that may be the source of controversy or division within those communities. (In many cases, these are the result of conflicts, sometimes violent ones, in home countries);
   and
- Our government respects the role of the federal government in the direction of our foreign policy and the protocol obligations that arise from that.

In the case of the People's Republic of China and the Republic of China (Taiwan), Ottawa has had a policy for many years of not sending elected officials of ministerial rank on any official duties in Taiwan. Taiwan has economic missions to Canada, but not diplomatic relations.

To strike the right balance, I think it's appropriate:

- To participate as usual in key events in the community, particularly those with which we have long personal and historical ties;
- Be careful not to trigger concerns, either by words or action, that this participation is any more than normal engagement with the community; i.e. not a cause for any concern that our government is now seeking to intervene in a matter that is properly handled at the federal level.

**Slack** is a <u>cloud</u>-based set of team <u>collaboration tools</u> and <u>services</u>, founded by <u>Stewart Butterfield</u>. Slack began as an internal tool used by their company, <u>Tiny Speck</u>, in the development of <u>Glitch</u>, a now defunct online game. The name is an acronym for "Searchable Log of All Conversation and Knowledge".

Slack teams allow communities, groups, or teams to join through a specific URL or invitation sent by a team admin or owner. Although Slack was meant for organizational communication, it has been slowly turning into a community platform, a function for which users had previously used message boards or social media such as Facebook or LinkedIn groups. [25] Many of these communities are categorized by topics which a group of people may be interested in discussing.

Public channels allow team members to communicate without the use of email or group SMS (texting). They are open to everyone in the chat provided they have first been invited to join the client. Private channels allow for private conversation between smaller sects of the overall group. These can be used to break up large teams into their own respective projects. Direct messages allow users to send private messages to a specific user rather than a group of people. Direct messages can include up to nine people (the originator plus eight people). Once started this direct message group can be converted to a private channel.

Hello. This was sent out to caucus a short time ago.

As discussed in caucus, the BC Government is filing today in the B.C. Supreme Court, responding to a petition by the Squamish Nation challenging the province's decision to grant the Kinder Morgan pipeline an environmental certificate and alleging the province failed in its constitutional duty to consult with the First Nation.

Minister Heyman is our spokesperson on this issue. Caucus members should direct requests for interviews or more in-depth comment to the Minister's office and to stay within the messages outlined below for any brief comments you may need to make on this issue. The Minister's Assistant is Caelie Frampton who can be reached at 778-678-2028.

#### Key messages:

- Our government remains committed to defending B.C.'s interests in the face of the construction of Trans Mountain's new pipeline and a dangerous seven-fold increase in tanker traffic on our coast.
- We will continue to use every tool to defend BC's interests.
- In the case of the BC Supreme Court, B.C. government lawyers will be arguing that the Crown lived up to its duty to consult, as it was defined at the time. This is based on independent legal opinions confirming that this is the best course of action for our provincial government at this time. (MLAs are strongly discouraged from saying more on the subject of the BC Supreme Court case)
- We are looking towards the Province's intervention in the Federal Court of Appeal, which starts next week.
- The Federal Court of Appeal has the authority to set aside the National Energy Board's approval of the new Trans Mountain pipeline.
- Fighting for intervenor status in the Federal Court of Appeal case gives the Government of BC the best opportunity to protect the health and safety of the BC coastline, BC's economy and our overall interests.
- We only recently won intervener status and it's a really significant win for the Province to be at the table arguing the case, with Thomas Berger representing the BC Government

As we discussed, a large group of key Kinder Morgan stakeholders are being called to inform them about what the BC Government is doing related to the legal actions at the provincial and federal levels.

Tonight is the informal opening of the First Nations Leadership Gathering – an annual meeting. The reception tonight and two days of meetings following will be held at the Vancouver Convention Centre. Please see the note below to understand the structure of the gathering.

#### Agenda

For those of you that have not reviewed the Agenda, please see attached.

The event launches with a third-party reception this evening hosted by the BC Federation of Labour and the BC Business Council. This is the first year the BC Fed has been a co-host. If you are in town, please join.

The crux of the Gathering is 1:1 meetings between local First Nations and Ministers. In some cases, MLA's will be joining Ministers when it is geographically relevant. Concurrent to the 1:1 meetings are plenaries on a variety of topics. Anyone is welcome to attend but space is often limited in plenaries. The Premier and FNLC are holding a joint media availability on Wednesday morning. After welcoming remarks, PJH will speak. Minister Fraser will close the Gathering on Thursday afternoon.

#### 1:1 Meetings

Ministers are hosting 1:1 meetings throughout the day. Note that MA's must be with them in the meetings. In almost all cases, DM's will be there as well. There are some meetings in which Ministers and DM's are joining the Premier. The meetings are 15 minutes long and there will be a scribe and timekeeper provided to them. Ministers have been provided with briefs and the Ministry will follow up with the notes following the Gathering.

#### **Invitations**

The FNLG has traditionally only been for Ministers and Chiefs. This year we invited the entire caucus as well as the Green caucus, the Liberal critic and Ellis Ross. My understanding is that a few additional Liberal MLA's are choosing to attend. An invitation was extended to each First Nation chief to bring a youth delegate with them. We want everyone to feel welcome.

#### **Additional Information**

There is a rally planned outside of the convention centre related to fish farms. It is expected that many from inside will attend.
