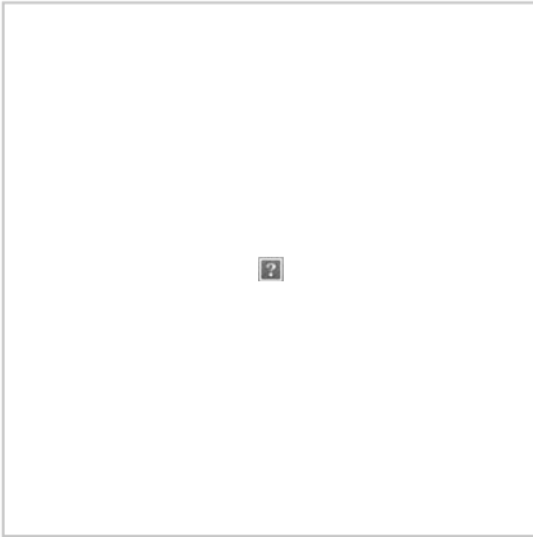

ISSUE: Potential Alberta obstruction of oil shipments to BC.

BACKGROUND: In March 2018, Alberta Premier Notley raised the possibility of restricting Alberta's oil and gas shipments to BC in response to perceived delays of Kinder Morgan's Trans Mountain Pipeline expansion project.

On April 8, Kinder Morgan announced that it would suspend "non-essential" spending on the pipeline until there is greater certainty. Premier Notley subsequently indicated that Alberta will introduce legislation in the coming days that would give it the ability to restrict oil shipments to BC.
