

Dear Mr. Wilkinson:

Thank you for your letter regarding the threat to the workers in British Columbia's pulp and paper industry. We share the same perspective on the urgency of the issue as was clear from last week's statements in the Legislature.

Since the threat emerged, the Minister of Jobs, Trade and Technology has been actively working with a number of parties to find ways to stand up for our industry. Before the decision on anti-dumping tariffs was made, the minister met in-person with Ned Dwyer, Catalyst CEO, to discuss tariffs and potential impacts.

Following the decision, as you are aware, the minister released a public statement regarding the tariffs. He had telephone calls with Graham Kissack (Government Relations at Catalsyt), Unifor Local 76 President Mike Rumley (Powell River Catalyst Mill), Natural Resources Minister Jim Carr, and Trade Minister Chrystia Freeland's office. I also expressed our concern and anger to Governor of Washington Jay Inslee during his recent visit. The minister has been assured by Ottawa that we will receive the same support for the pulp sector in the face of American attacks as has been extended to the softwood sector.

Our office has written to Prime Minister Trudeau and to key American trade officials underlining our rejection of this action. While we continue to work with the federal government to fight these unfair tariffs, it is clear that this problem lies in Washington, not Ottawa.

To ensure we have a strong understanding of the terrain, I have asked Minister Ralston to arrange for a briefing for you and Andrew Weaver by senior federal government officials. We will be looking to do this at the earliest opportunity and will keep you apprised of any developments.
