



Premier Brian Pallister announced changes to the provincial cabinet today and welcomed one new member to cabinet.

"Since our election in April of 2016, our government has focused on fixing the finances, repairing the services and rebuilding the economy of our province," said Pallister. "Our team has made great progress. Taxes have been lowered, the deficit has come down, we are seeing record private investment in our province, bond rating agencies are giving Manitoba a vote of confidence and emergency room wait times have come down.

"We have achieved this through a strong team. But there is much left to do. Today, I'm announcing some key changes and additions to the team that build on the significant progress achieved over the first two years and position us for further improvements in our finances, services and economy over the second half of our mandate."

Pallister welcomed Colleen Mayer, MLA for St. Vital, as the new minister of Crown services.

He also announced new portfolios for the following ministers:

As mentioned on the Daily this morning, here is some information on the Trump administration's plans to change vehicle emission standards and limit the rights of states to set their own pollution standards (which is a direct attack on California's climate leadership):

The Trump administration on Thursday unveiled its long-awaited proposal to dramatically weaken an Obama-era regulation designed to limit vehicle emissions, which contribute to climate change.

The <u>publication</u> of the proposal sets up a race among opponents of the change — an unusual mix of environmentalists, automakers, consumer groups and states — to temper the plan before it is finalized this year.

The proposal would freeze rules requiring automakers to build cleaner, more fuel-efficient cars, including hybrids and electric vehicles, and unravel one of President Barack Obama's signature policies to combat global warming. It would also challenge the right of states to set their own, more stringent tailpipe pollution standards, setting the stage for a legal clash that could ultimately split the nation's auto market in two.

Several staff from the Canada School of Public Service would also form part of the group.

The primary goal of the tour is to provide opportunities for participants to take part in conversations with executives and leaders at all levels of government, non-governmental organizations, the academic sector,

indigenous communities, and the private sector. The meetings are designed to provide an opportunity for an exchange of perspectives and insights on governance and leadership principles, challenges and innovations as well as current and emerging public policy issues.

In addition, the meetings will allow participants to:

- * Increase knowledge and appreciation for diverse regional perspectives (opportunities/challenges and strategic edge/innovation) and take these into consideration to advance the Government of Canada priorities and agenda;

Background

The British Columbia Consular Corps, based mainly in Vancouver, is the official body comprising all Consular Officers (Consuls General, Consuls, Vice-Consuls and Consular Agents) resident in the Province, representing 83 countries (55 honorary members; 31 career members) as of July 2018. Some countries have more than one office in B.C. Some Consular Officers based in British Columbia also have jurisdiction in other provinces and territories. Canadian citizens residing in British Columbia may be asked to represent a country as an Honorary Consular Officer. The Office of Protocol is responsible for the administration of immunities, privileges and benefits, resolves any issues that consulates may encounter and is responsible for fostering positive government to government relations with the representatives of foreign countries.

Primary functions of Consular Officers:

- Represent their country and promote their country's trade within the Consular District;
- Assist and protect nationals of their country;
- Explain their country's policies and achievements in fields such as culture and tourist attractions;
- Protect their country's shipping interests, legalize ship's papers, assist their country's seamen in distress and adjudicate on certain shipping matters; and
- Administer oaths, legalize foreign documents and issue passports, visas and certificates.

To continuously support and interact with the Consular Corps, including welcoming official visitors and attending National Day activities, the Government generally arranges two annual briefing/reception events each year. One is of a "technical" nature with presentations by Deputy Ministers with the other being by Ministers and a reception hosted by the Premier. The last ministerial briefing took place in Victoria on March 10, 2018.



VICTORIA - Premier John Horgan and Bruce Ralston, Minister of Jobs, Trade and Technology, have issued the following statement in response to the U.S. International Trade Commission's (ITC) unanimous finding of no injury on B.C.'s Catalyst Paper's newsprint exports to the United States.

"People who work at Catalyst on Vancouver Island, in Powell River and Metro Vancouver can breathe more easily today. Today's ruling means that Catalyst will no longer have to pay these debilitating, unfair duties. We're very pleased with the outcome and we're glad the ITC has made the right decision based on the evidence before it. This is good news for people who work in the newsprint industry.

"This case was launched by a single Washington state mill. Although this case is now over and the duties will be refunded, the damage it has inflicted on Catalyst and other Canadian producers is disturbing.

"The pulp and paper industry is an important contributor to B.C.'s economy. Catalyst's B.C. operations support about 6,500 people directly and indirectly in three communities in B.C.

"Our government, the federal government, local mayors and councils, the company and workers stood together to protect the jobs and economy of coastal communities - and we will continue to vigorously defend B.C. against future unfair U.S. litigation.

"The governments of B.C. and Canada demonstrated clearly during the investigation that they had not been subsidizing Catalyst's operations, and we're satisfied by today's decision by the ITC."

Background:

The ruling means that the combined countervailing and anti-dumping duties of 20.26% applied

by the U.S. Department of Commerce to B.C.'s Catalyst Paper's newsprint products since its final anti-dumping and countervailing duty determination of Aug. 2, 2018, will no longer apply. The duties on Catalyst's products that had been applied since Jan. 16, 2018 will now be refunded.

No deal has been reached yet. Negotiations will resume next week after the long week-end.

She refused to answer any specific questions (e.g. supply management) citing an understanding with her American counterpart to avoid negotiating in public.

She insisted that her American counterparts and his staff have been negotiating in good faith.

With respect to tariffs on aluminum and steel, she reiterated that they are a separate issue, distinct from NAFTA. She reiterated Canada's position - i.e., tariffs = absurd.
