Earlier this year, the Premier and Cabinet had asked that a process be developed to assess and monitor the impact of government policy decisions on businesses and the economy and to incorporate impact information in proposals being advanced for Cabinet and Cabinet Committee consideration.

I am writing to introduce the **Business and Economic Implications Framework** (BEIF) and to ask that you advise staff of the new requirements. The BEIF was developed by the Ministry of Jobs, Trade and Technology to provide a standard assessment approach. JTT will provide support and assistance as the BEIF is established, establish capacity to track cumulative impacts and review the BEIF after 6 months to ensure that it is meeting its intended purpose.

Effective January 1, 2019, ministries submitting **new** Requests for Decision, Requests for Legislation and Orders in Council intended for Cabinet and Cabinet Committee consideration will be expected to complete the screening and evaluation tools included in the framework. The framework and related screening tools and worksheets are available at http://gww.cabops.gov.bc.ca/templates/.

Training tools have been developed to assist with implementing the framework, including in-person workshops and a self-serve training module on @work. Registration for workshops can be done through the Learning System (Business and Economic Implications Framework – Workshop). Priority registration may be given to teams that are developing submissions that will be considered early in 2019.


