- PMJT has scheduled announcement in Hamilton today, where he and Min. Freeland are expected to announce a deal to lift the Trump administrations' steel and aluminum tariffs.
- PMJT spoke with POTUS today (3<sup>rd</sup> time in 7 days) on tariffs and other trade matters.
- "In exchange for getting the tariffs lifted, Canada and Mexico would agree to actions meant to stop steel and aluminium from China and other countries being sent to the U.S. through Canada and Mexico. They would also lift their retaliatory tariffs on the U.S."
- "Industry sources listed two specific measures: One is a 'rules of origin' requirement on Canadian and Mexican-made steel and aluminium that would mandate a specific per centage of the metal had originated in Canada and Mexico – a move meant to discourage, for instance, a Canadian company importing scrap from China and melting it down for sale to the U.S."
- "The other measure would require Canada and Mexico to better track and monitor steel shipments to make sure China wasn't passing the product through them to get around U.S. tariffs."
- "unlikely that we're going to have unbridled free trade in steel and aluminum."

Notable:

- three interim whale sanctuaries in key foraging areas — one at Swiftsure Bank and two off Saturna and Pender Islands.
- Recreational and commercial salmon fishing closures in specific areas that will take effect after current catch-and-release restrictions on chinook salmon expire July 31. The restrictions will remain in effect until Oct. 31.
- Doubling the mandatory no-go zone around whales to 400 metres from 200 metres for all vessels in critical habitat areas, which extend along southern Vancouver Island through the Gulf Islands to the mouth of the Fraser River.
