British Columbia wants to expand and diversify our presence in Asia, connect more closely with the federal government's international resources \$.13

That's why we are transitioning our trade and investment services in Asia from a contractor model to one where we colocate provincial public servants in Canadian Embassies and Consulates.

We think this change will better help B.C. businesses and give British Columbian's the best value for the investment they are making.

Background

• B.C.'s Asian Trade Investment Representative TIR offices are in Beijing, Shanghai, Guangzhou, Hong Kong, Tokyo, Seoul, Manila, Jakarta, Singapore, New Delhi, Mumbai, Chandigarh, and Hyderbad.

- Under the new model, the Province will no longer carry the costs of contractors and independent office leases.
 Instead, public servants will be co-located in the Government of Canada's consulates and embassies throughout Asia.
- This operational change is focused on improved service delivery s.13
- Any cost savings from a transition to embedded resources is being redeployed to expansion of our network and increased program dollars to support BC business activities.
- By updating staffing levels to reflect current opportunities and the interests of BC businesses we expect there to be no budget impact.

Today we will be informing our trade and investment representatives in Asia that we will not be contracting for their services beyond spring 2020. Future international market activities in Asia will be made through co-locating provincial public servants in the Government of Canada's Embassies and Consulates in the respective countries.

As you know, the province is making a concerted effort to diversify its international activities through the new International Engagement Framework. By being connected more closely with our federal partners we will broaden our network for businesses development, lower fixed costs for taxpayers and give ourselves more flexibility to expand our presence in Asia as we diversify our international activities. Some of our trade and investment's representatives' contracts will expire at the end of March and others will be provided notice as per their contract conditions. There are no changes to our representation in the United States or Europe. This new co-location model will take effect on April 1, 2020 for all offices in Asia.
