

Jade Mining in BC

Jade is British Columbia's provincial gemstone and has both a healthy domestic and international market. Nephrite Jade is an important stone used traditionally by Indigenous communities in the northwest and is traded widely throughout the Province. It is also highly valued by the Chinese community.



Jade is mined primarily in the remote Turnagain region of Northwest BC, about 60km east of Dease Lake, and the Cassiar/Jade City area, about 100km north of Dease Lake. s.12
