Regardless of whether or not we do that, will we need supplementals beyond the money for the aid cheques?

We obviously won't have much drafting capacity between now and December, so we don't want to signal to ministries that the window is open by any more than the thinnest little crack. But Amy, could you send out a note to DMs inquiring if there is any we're-all-going-to-die-without-it legislation requirements?
