**ISSUE(S):** This meeting is an opportunity for the Premier and Minister to connect with Professor Mazzucato, s.13

#### **BACKGROUND:**

- Mariana Mazzucato is a Professor in the Economics of Innovation and Public Value at University College London (UCL), where she is the founding director of the Institute for Innovation and Public Purpose. Her work challenges orthodox thinking about the role of the state and the private sector in driving innovation; how economic value is created, measured and shared; and how marketshaping policy can be designed in a 'mission oriented way' to solve the grand challenges facing humanity.
- Mariana Mazzucato's work on the relationship between innovation and the
  direction of economic growth is having a global impact. Over the last two years,
  her work has influenced a new mission-oriented approach to E.U. Innovation
  policy; redesigned a 'challenge-oriented' U.K. industrial policy; and helped
  create a new National Investment bank in Scotland. She acts as an advisor to a
  wide range of governments and organisations around the world, including the
  Italian Prime Minister, the President of South Africa, the Vatican and the World
  Economic Forum.
- Professor Mazzucato has proposed that as jurisdictions design their economic support mechanisms of recovery, they consider the concepts of not returning to the pre-COVID-19 normal and "do capitalism differently"; taking into consideration the province's longer term goals, such as climate action, Indigenous reconciliation and inclusion and aligning support in a way that accelerates progress to these goals.
- Professor Mazzucato has also proposed that public funding is critical to the process of innovation and wealth creation. Public organizations and

governments should design their innovation support to de-risk, stimulate innovation and receive longer term return, in addition to taxes for successful innovations that excel based on government investment.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

- Minister Kahlon met with Professor Mazzucato on March 1, 2021 and April 10, 2021, to discuss B.C.'s interest in receiving the advice of the Institute for Innovation and Public Purpose, and specifically the advice of Professor Mazzucato, as the Province develops a new economic narrative for the fall.
- Some questions to ask Professor Mazzucato for consideration:
  - How have governments that are being successful in redefining capitalism identified their priorities for investment and economic growth that align with their social or public welfare objectives?
  - Who is gettting it right and what were their biggest hurdles/failures when they were getting started?
  - What were the most important or smartest questions asked by the jurisdictions having success with the mission oriented approach?
  - Most businesses in B.C. are small businesses. How can a small, subnational government involve small businesses in the transition to a new version of investment and capitalism? What are some of the important tools governments have used to successfully help small businesses scale up?
  - What are the key "how's" government's should consider when they are drafting policy – what policy levers should government's use? What should government's avoid?
  - Are ESG considerations likely to advantage B.C. products and services in the global marketplace?
  - How can we grow the public and business buy-in to the province's challenges and missions? Have you seen governments do this well/poorly? What made a difference?
  - What does the new curriculum for politicians and public servants look like that is needed to support a new way of looking at innovation and government investment?

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
