The Festival is jointly hosted by the Canadian Alliance of Chinese Associations (CACA) and the Canada Sichuanese Friendship Association (CSFA). The Frist Chinese Culture and Arts Festival Zigong Lantern Show lit up the downtown Vancouver Art Gallery Plaza and opened the door to the colorful Chinese culture for citizens. Last year due to the pandemic, artists from China and Canada were invited to arrange a splendid online performance of the Second China Cultural And Arts Festival through internet. This year the organizers will bring wonderful live performances at the famous Jack Poole Plaza, including traditional dragon dances and lion dances, waist drum long silk, Shaolin Kungfu, Sanxing Tai Chi and ethnic costumes exhibition. There will also be 50 young people painting on-site and the event will be broadcasted live on Tencent's network.

The Canadian Alliance of Chinese Associations CACA is a BC-based, registered nonprofit, composed of over 100 immigrant associations, built on unity, mutuality, devotion, and teamwork. We pursue the integration of Chinese newcomers within the fabric of Canadian society, encouraging participation of our association members in local philanthropic activities, in addition to promoting Canadian-Chinese economic and cultural exchange. Since the outbreak of COVID19 in early 2020, CACA has repeatedly donated to hospitals, nursing homes, community centers and special populations in the Greater Vancouver community; in July 2021, it has donated nearly 50,000 Canadian dollars to the fire damaged village of Lytton BC.

The Canada Sichuanese Friendship Association (CSFA) was established in 1996, it is a non-profit, non-religious organization, which aims to connect those from Sichuan Province in the Greater Vancouver area and strengthen ties between members. During the pandemic, it donated anti-epidemic materials to Richmond Hospital, many nursing homes and communities in Greater Vancouver, and have donated to RMHC for 3 consecutive years; in July 2021, it has donated nearly 13,000 Canadian dollars to the fire damaged village of Lytton BC.
