- Additional orders in place for Northern Health regions.
- LNG Canada will adopt a mandatory vaccination program. Staff and contractors are required to prove their full vaccination status by November 30<sup>th</sup>.

- LNG Canada has minimal cases as of mid October. Coastal GasLink has 15 new cases as of October 17<sup>th</sup>.

- Direct engagement with LNG Canada and Coastal GasLink remains strong
- Shortage of skilled workers
- Housing ‘crunch’

- MUNI reporting what was heard to LNG Canada/Coastal GasLink
- Social & Economic Management Committee (SEMC) assessing key themes, evaluating government response
- Engagement continues in February 2022

- MUNI continues to host first round of facilitated sessions.

- Internal engagement with ministries; information dissemination to SEMC, as well as LNG Canada and Coastal GasLink
- Follow-up direct engagement; sessions in February/March 2022

# LNG Canada Project Progress Update

- As of the end of August 2021, LNG Canada reported their total workforce as <sup>s.21</sup> workers employed. Of this total, roughly <sup>s.21</sup> are Canadian and <sup>s.21</sup> are from B.C. As of September 2021, peak beds at Cedar Valley Lodge is <sup>s.21</sup>
- On October 6<sup>th</sup>, LNG Canada reported that the project is over 50% complete, moving towards the expected mid-decade in-service date.

# Coastal GasLink Project Progress Update

- In July 2021, Coastal GasLink completed the opening of their workforce accommodation centres. As of the end of September 2021, 12 lodges are open and operational, housing <sup>s.21</sup> workers.
- Recently, CGL reached the highest elevation point on the project route, 1,428m above sea level at the top of Icy Pass.
- As of October 17, 2021, Coastal GasLink has reported their total workforce as ~4,482 individuals.
