ISSUE: Update regarding Enbridge Inc.'s Westcoast Connector Gas Transmission Project

SUMMARY:

- s.17
- s.17 Ksi Lisims LNG—a liquefied natural gas facility developed through an alliance of Rockies LNG, Western LNG and the Nisga'a Nation—as a potential recipient of WCGT gas.
- The Ksi Lisims LNG facility intends to be fully electrified within five years of commencing operations and has estimated its facility emissions to be approximately 0.2 MtCO₂e – making it one of the lowest emitting LNG facilities in the world.

BACKGROUND:

Enbridge is a global energy infrastructure company with headquarters in Calgary, Alberta. Its activities and assets include oil and gas distribution and storage as well as liquids and natural gas pipeline infrastructure. Enbridge also has a diversified portfolio of renewable energy projects, both wind and solar, in Canada and abroad. Enbridge has and continues to play a prominent role in the natural gas sector of British Columbia (BC). They are the backbone of natural gas distribution in BC, providing energy security throughout the Province with their Westcoast Transmission pipeline.

The proposed WCGT project is an 850 km long, 48 inch diameter, 4.2 Bcf/day capacity natural gas pipeline project from the Cypress area in northeast BC to Ridley Island, near Prince Rupert. Ridley Island was previously the preferred location of a since-cancelled liquefaction export facility. It crosses the traditional territory of Treaty 8 Nations including Blueberry River First Nation (BRFN). It also crosses the traditional territories of approximately 20 other Nations including the Gitksan, Gitanyow, and Lax Kw'alaams Nations.

DISCUSSION:

GHG emissions

The Province has established a greenhouse gas emission reduction target of 40 percent below 2007 levels by 2030 and has made a commitment to achieve net zero emissions by 2050. In addition, the Province has also set an oil and gas sector emission reduction of a 33-38 percent reduction from 2007 levels by 2030. The recent CleanBC Roadmap to 2030 sets out a path to fully achieve its 2030 target. However, the modelling assumes BC will produce 14 million tonnes of LNG (roughly LNG Canada's expected production)—it would not include emissions from a Ksi Lisims LNG facility, the WCGT pipeline or incremental upstream natural gas extraction and processing to supply Ksi Lisims.

One of the four principles of approving LNG development has been that any new development will fit within emission reduction targets. According to their 2014 EAC application, the WCGT, s.17 would have about 0.7 million tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent (MtCO₂e) emissions. If it were to transport a greater amount of natural gas, the pipeline emissions would be closer to 2.5 MtCO₂e. (Because methane emissions are a relatively small part of the pipeline emissions (~5%), recent methane policy is not likely to materially change this level of emissions.) WCGT has indicated its intent to mitigate emissions via electrification of the pipeline during operational phase 1.

The Ksi Lisims LNG facility intends to be fully electrified within five years of commencing operations and has estimated its facility emissions to be approximately 0.2 MtCO₂e and the emissions associated with its purchased electricity at 0.05-0.2 Mt CO₂e. It has stated its intention to purchase offsets for all facility and acquired electricity emissions. At the current time, proponent purchase of offsets would not be considered in assessing the Province's achievement of emission reductions targets. However, as the net-zero 2050 commitment is legislated, further compliance options to achieve the target, including the purchase of offsets, may be considered. The facility has flagged that there is a risk that they would not be able to be fully connected to the BC Hydro electricity when they start operations. In this case, electricity would be generated onsite from natural gas combustion with emissions up to 1.9 MtCO₂e. In this event, Ksi Lisims would still purchase between 0.25-0.40 million tonnes of offsets, leaving a significant amount of emissions of non-offsetted emissions.

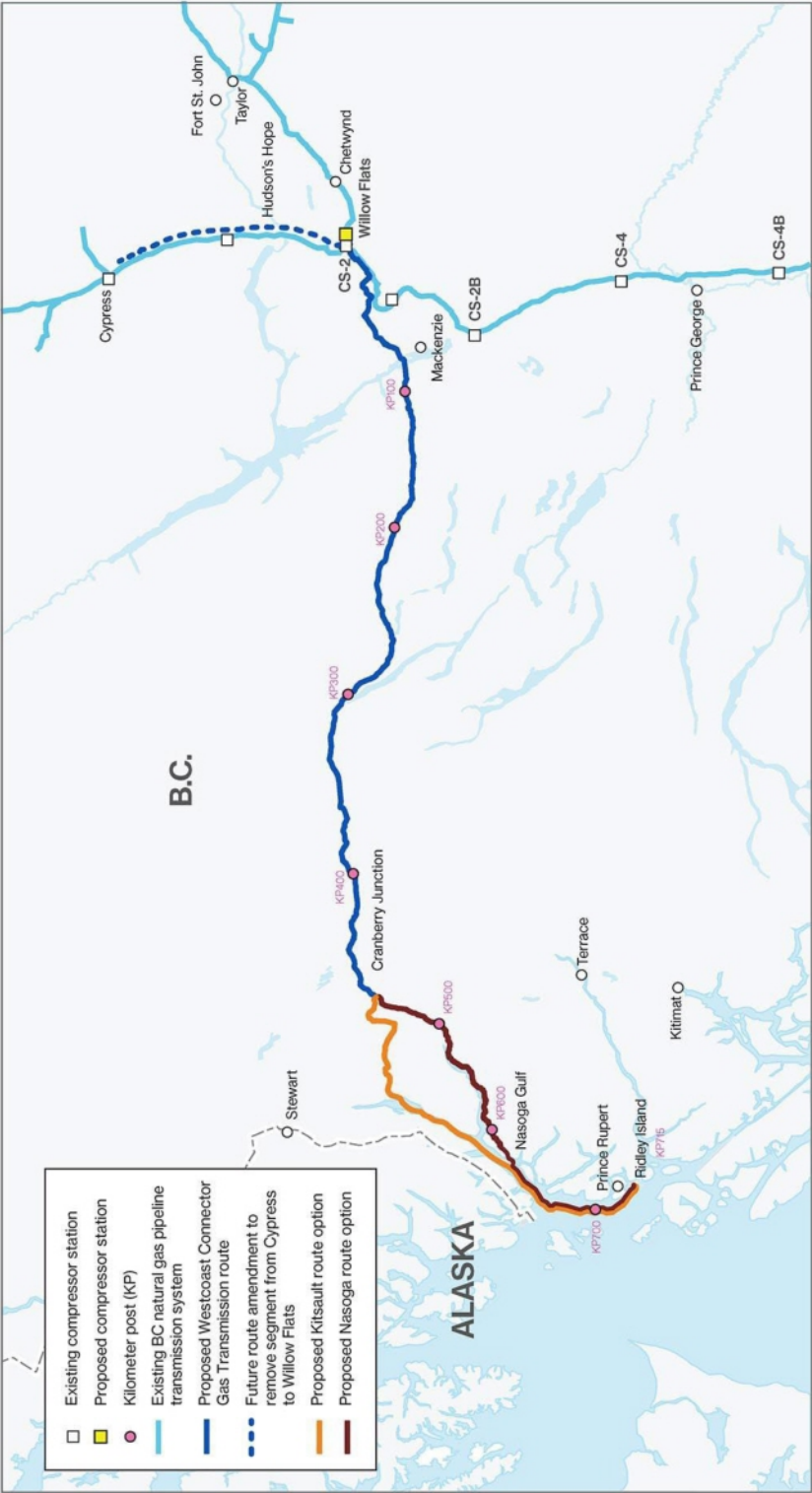
