Eby: Thanks. I've been on the phone over the last few days with leadership from Muslim organizations and from Jewish organizations and Indigenous organizations. Specifically, we had the most meetings with the National Council of Canadian Muslims, discussions about how to move forward.

Reporter: This is on another topic. Crown prosecutors are asking that the provincial court in Vancouver be moved from 222 Main. There was a recent assault there, and there are other safety concerns in the area. Are you considering that?

Eby: No. We're not currently considering relocating that courthouse. What I can say is that I'm certainly very concerned about this assault on a Crown prosecutor and the safety of every person that uses that courthouse, as well as more broadly in the neighbourhood.

We have done a lot of work to address issues of community safety in Vancouver and in other parts of the province around repeat violent offenders, around bail conditions, and repeat offenders generally in the province. We have made some progress. But we've got a lot more work to do here.

I have talked with the attorney general. She will be reaching out to the Crown Counsel Association and she is working with the justice administration folks in her ministry, as well as with the courts, to ensure safety for everybody.

This is not the first incident in recent memory involving safety in our courts. Earlier this year, we had a handgun brought into a courthouse and threats towards defence council. And before that we had a stabbing at a courthouse of a party that was participating in litigation. We will continue the work we have been doing to ensuring safety of all court participants, no matter who they are.

Reporter: With hindsight, do you wish you'd handled this differently to prevent four days of cancelled events, fundraisers, the partial Mosque ban, protests outside caucus this morning?

Reporter: I do. It's on behalf of a colleague and it relates to the foreign buyers ban being extended. They were hoping to get your reaction to the federal extension of the foreign buyer ban and whether or not you think it made any difference since it was initially announced back in 2022.

Eby: In British Columbia we're proud to have in place clear restrictions around international money in our housing market. And the Speculation and Vacancy Tax, the [inaudible] Buyer Tax, the beneficial Ownership registry, so that we're able to enforce it all, because we don't want people parking money in the housing market and not living here. The goal is to build up our communities and ensure that homes are places for people to live.

I don't expect the extension of the federal foreign buyers ban to have a significant impact on the housing market here in British Columbia as a result. But it may have an impact in other provinces where they don't have these protections.

Reporter: Over the weekend, it was announced that Vancouver would be hosting seven Men's World Cup games in 2026. It has been unclear publicly largely about the burden on the province to host these seven games. Do you have a firm understanding about how much this is going to cost British Columbians to host these games, what sort of work the province is being asked by FIFA to undertake here, and are you confident that this is a winner for the province to host this many games for the 2026 World Cup?

Eby: For FIFA, we did receive some good news that there will be seven FIFA games in BC in Vancouver, which is great news for soccer fans. And in terms of the cost of hosting the FIFA event, there's some fixed costs, changes that need to be made to the stadium, making sure that there's the turf field and other requirements around security to be able to accommodate an event of this scale, and then there's some operational costs that are additional RCMP time, policing time and staffing time that will expand given how many additional games are offered here.

The good news is that we get revenue back from tickets that are sold to help offset costs. So the Ministry of Finance will be doing the work with FIFA going forward to understand what this means in terms of offsetting costs or incurring additional costs.

We'll have more to share about that going forward.

We also have a cost-sharing agreement with the federal government, and we'll have to update that work with them.
