Issue: In order for Simon Fraser University (the University) to progress its self-funded Surrey Campus Expansion project, the University is requesting Ministerial approval of the following dispositions:

Background / Facts:

- The University has been working collaboratively with the City for several years to develop a
 mutually beneficial plan to support the development of the University's Surrey Campus Expansion
 project and the City-owned Surrey City Centre lands. s.16
- Through its land planning process, the University has identified a goal to expand its Surrey campus
 to carry out its self-directed mandate of becoming a fully comprehensive campus, with the capacity
 for an additional 2,500 full-time equivalent students. This will address the capacity pressures in
 Surrey, the Province's fastest-growing city with the fewest post-secondary seats per capita of any
 jurisdiction in Metro Vancouver.
- To achieve this goal, the University has sought to improve its land holdings in Surrey by working
 with the City to develop a plan and acquire the land, creating certainty for both the University and
 the City around the transit, road, and development issues that may impact the development
 potential of the University's lands for the Surrey Campus Expansion project and future expansion
 projects, as well as of the City's Surrey Centre lands.
