VC73 TO 3737 ANGUS DR, REQUESTED ON SECOND ALARM. THIS IS A STRUCTURE FIRE, BUILDING IS A TYPE 5 RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING. DUE TO THE INABILITY TO ENTER THE STRUCTURE DUE TO STABILITY CONCERNS, UNABLE TO DETECT ANY FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEMS OTHER THAN GYPSUM AND LATHE. VC73 ARRIVED WITH VB03 A/C DENNIS, J. IN COMMAND. CREWS ON SCENE WERE ACTIVELY INVOLVED IN SUPPRESSION OF THE FIRE AT THIS TIME. ON ARRIVAL VC73 BEGAN TO COLLECT INFORMATION ON THIS INCIDENT. A 20LB PROPANE TANK WAS SEEN IN THE FRONT BOULEVARD, IT WAS LATER NOTED THAT SUPPRESSION CREWS REMOVED THIS FROM THE CARPORT AREA AS A SAFETY CONCERN. VRE03 CAPT. GELSVIK, C. INITIAL FIRE ATTACK, STATED THAT THIS STRUCTURE WAS FULLY INVOLVED ON THE BRAVO SIDE OF THE BUILDING. THE DOOR ON THE BRAVO SIDE OF THIS HOUSE WAS OPEN FROM HIS ACCOUNT. A/C DENNIS, J. ALSO DESCRIBED SEEING THE BRAVO SIDE DOOR BEING OPEN DURING HIS 360 OF THE BUILDING WHILE ESTABLISHING COMMAND. VM04 LT. SHIRLEY, D AND HIS CREW PASSED THE SAME BRAVO SIDE WITH SIMILAR ACCOUNTS, FF MCKAY, D OF VM04 WENT TO THE BRAVO CHARLIE SIDE OF THE BUILDING AND STATED THAT HE WITNESSED SEEING A SMALL FIRE IN THE CHARLIE SIDE WINDOW. VE18 CAPT ROSENLUND AND CREW ENTERED THE ALPHA SIDE DOOR AND ATTEMPTED TO EXTINGUISH WITH A 1 3/4' HANDLINE. IT WAS DEEMED TO BE A DEFENSIVE FIRE AND CREWS WERE ORDERED FROM THE BUILDING. VL03 HAD SET UP THE AERIAL TO ASSIST WITH FIRE TACTICS, AT THIS TIME FIRE HAD VENTED THROUGH THE ROOF OF THE STRUCTURE. VC73 REQUESTED DISPATCH FOR VPD TO ATTEND FOR A FIRE SUSPICIOUS IN NATURE. VPD INCIDENT #17-217602 PC'S 1923 AND 2406 IN ATTENDANCE. NEIGHBOURS IN PASSING HAD STATED THAT HOUSE HAD BEEN VACANT FOR APPROXIMATELY 5 YEARS. HYDRO AND GAS WERE STILL SERVICING THIS HOUSE. HYDRO AND FORTIS NOTIFIED AND DISCONNECTED POWER AND SHUT OFF THE GAS LINE. THIS HOUSE WAS VACANT AND UNFURNISHED. OWNERS NAME THROUGH CITYWIRE ADDRESS SEARCH. 5.22

VC73 REOUESTED CITY ENGINEERING THROUGH DISPATCH TO RESPOND TO INVESTIGATED THE STRUCTURAL INTEGRITY OF THE STRUCTURE. CITY ENGINEER MR. MARTIN, PAUL DEEMED THE AREA THAT IS SUSPECTED TO BE THE AREA OF ORIGIN TO UNSTABLE TO WORK WITHIN, ENGINEER WAS HAVING A BOARD UP CREW COMING TO SECURE THE BUILDING AND YARD. VC73 REQUESTED VPD TO HAVE VPD CAR 10 CALL, THIS LEAD TO BEING PUT IN CONTACT WITH MAJOR CRIME SECTION SGT. JENN DANIELS S. 15 . A REQUEST WAS MADE TO HAVE A VPD ARSON INVESTIGATOR ATTEND THIS INCIDENT AND FOR SCENE SECURITY AND A CONTINUITY OF EVIDENCE, SGT. DANIELS WASN'T ABLE TO PROVIDE THIS REQUEST.
