CAR 73 TO 4573 W 1ST AVE FOR STRUCTURE FIRE, FOUND B3, CHIEF ZACHARAK IN COMMAND, E19, CAPT. SEREDA, FIRST ON SCENE, E12, CAPT. BORTIGNON, FIRST IN FIRE ATTACK CREW. 4573 IS A RESIDENTIAL OCCUPANCY, 4 STORY SINGLE FAMILY HOME. BUILT IN 1914, TYPE5 CONSTRUCTION. FIRE PROTECTION INCLUDES SEVERAL SMOKE AND **s.22** BABYSITTER ONSITE A E19 CREWS REPORTED FINDING BLACK SMOKE ON THE 4TH FLOOR. DETECTORS ON ALL LEVELS. OWNER IS \$.22 BABYSITTER ONSITE AND REPORTED FIRE TO 911 IS s.22 CAPT. BORTIGNON E12, ENTERED AS FIRE ATTACK AND FOUND SMOKE AND MINIMAL FLAME, EXTINGUISHED WITH 1 LINE USING MINIMAL WATER. CREWS REMOVED A SKYLIGHT FOR INCREASED VENTILATION, THE FIRE BROKE OUT THE LARGE WINDOW ON THE NORTH EAST CORNER OF THE OFFICE AT THE ORIGIN AREA. INVESTIGATION: I AND LEARNED THAT APPROXIMATELY, 2 HOURS PRIOR, HE BROUGHT IN A 36VOLT LITHIUM ION BATTERY PACK AND CONNECTED TO THE MANUFACTURERS CHARGER. THE CHARGER IS FOR AN ELECTRIC BIKE (MOUNTAIN BIKE STYLE) MADE BY 'MONTAGUE' THE PARATROOPER MODEL, WITH THE CRYSTALYTE DRIVE SYSTEM. THE LI ION BATTERY CHARGER IS MODEL LI-36040 MADE BY ELECTRIC RIDER (SALES@ELECTRICRIDER.COM) AROUND 6PM THE BABYSITTER, \$.22 , HEARD A SINGLE BANG, INVESTIGATED AND THOUGHT IT WAS THE POOL. SHE THEN HEARD A SECOND BANG, AGAIN FOUND NOTHING, AND THOUGHT IT WAS FROM THE NEIGHBORS, A THIRD LOUD BANG OCCURED, AND SHE AGAIN THOUGHT IT CAME FROM THE NEIGHBORS, BUT THEN FOUND SMOKE AND EXITED THE HOME AND CALLED 911. I FOUND SEVERAL CYLINDRICAL SHAPED OBJECTS, (SLIGHTLY LARGER THAN AN AA BATTERY SIZE) AT VARIOUS POINTS OF DISPOSITION IN THE AREA OF ORIGIN. THE MAJORITY WERE STILL COUPLED AS A UNIT AND AT THE POINT OF ORIGIN IDENTIFIED BY THE BURN DEPTH INTO THE FLOOR AND CHARRING ON THE NEARBY WINDOW FRAME. OTHER CYLINDERS HAD SEPARATED FROM THIS GROUPING; ONE WAS SEVERAL FEET FROM THE AREA OF ORIGIN AND HAD BURNED INTO THE FLOORING. OTHERS WERE INTACT, OR FULLY BLOWN OPEN, AND OTHERS WERE DISPLAYING HARDENED GLOBS OF CHEMICAL (LEAD?) SEEPING OUT THE ENDS OF THE CYLINDERS. INVESTIGATION CONCLUDES THIS TO BE AN ACCIDENTAL FIRE, CAUSED BY A MALFUNCTION OF THE BATTERY CHARGING UNIT, AND OR BY THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAKE UP OF THE 36VOLT ELECTRICAL BATTERY CELLS. FURTHER TESTING WOULD BE REQUIRED TO ASCERTAIN THE ACTION THAT CAUSED THE BATTERIES TO REACH EXTREME TEMPERATURES AND EXPLODE, CAUSING THE FIRE. FIRE DAMAGE IS CONSIDERABLE, SMOKE AND HEAT DAMAGE ALSO SEVERE TO THE UPPER OFFICE / GAMES ROOM SPACE.
