NOVEMBER 27, 2017 09:50 - I ARRIVED ON SCENE TO INTERVIEW SUPPRESSION CREW. INCIDENT COMMANDER ASSISTANT CHIEF SCOBIE INFORMED ME THAT; ON ARRIVAL HE SAW FLAME FROM THE FRONT BASEMENT WINDOW, WITH A LITTLE BIT OF FLAME IN STAIRWAY, AND GREY/BLACK SMOKE THROUGHOUT BUILDING BUT HEAVIER IN BASEMENT. THE BUILDING OWNER INFORMED AC SCOBIE THAT HE OPENED THE DOOR TO THE FIRE UNIT. I SPOKE WITH FIRE FIGHTER JAY WINKEL WHO INFORMED ME THAT WHILE ADVANCING THE HOSE LINE TO THE CHARLIE/DELTA CORNER HE SAW 3 FOOT FLAMES EXITING THE BASEMENT WINDOW ON THE C/D CORNER. FF WINKEL ALSO REPORTED SEEING A 'STUBBORN GREEN FLAME COMING OUT FROM BELOW WHAT APPEARED TO BE THE BED'. 10:27 - I LEFT SCENE TO RETURN TO HALL 1 TO GATHER INVESTIGATION EQUIPMENT. 11:17 - BACK ON SCENE TO BEGIN INVESTIGATION. STARTED INVESTIGATION BY PHOTOGRAPHING EXTERIOR AND INTERIOR OF BUILDING. FIRE MOVEMENT AND INTENSITY PATTERNS SHOWED AREA OF ORIGIN TO BE THE BEDROOM LOCATED IN THE NORTHWEST (C/D) CORNER OF THE BASEMENT. AFTER EXCAVATION AND RECONSTRUCTION OF THE BEDROOM I DETERMINED THE POINT OF ORIGIN TO BE UNDER THE BED NEAR THE EAST SIDE EDGE. THE ONLY COMPETENT IGNITION SOURCE AT THE POINT OF ORIGIN WAS AN EXTENSION CORD THAT APPEARED TO BE WRAPPED AROUND THE BED FRAME. I BELIEVE THE 'STUBBORN GREEN FLAME' REPORTED BY FIRE FIGHTER WINKEL WAS CAUSED BY THE BURNING OF ALLOY BICYCLE RIMS AS THERE WERE NUMEROUS RIMS PRESENT IN THE AREA OF ORIGIN. 14:30 - RELEASED SCENE TO INSURANCE ADJUSTER EUGENE BRISCHUK (250-277-2543), LEFT SCENE AND RETURNED TO HALL 1.
