Ministers Donaldson and Farnworth,

We are writing to you with a matter of the utmost urgency. As you are aware, wildfires are threatening areas across northern British Columbia, all of these are in our constituencies.

As the elected representatives of these areas, we have heard first-hand concerns that there are a lack of resources and personnel available to effectively fight these fires. Additionally, we have heard concerns from public safety representatives that adequate resources to effectively manage a large-scale evacuation order are not in place.

We would like to know the government's strategy for acquisition and deployment of resources to help fight the fires on the front lines. There have been concerns that local fire prevention experts like Jeff Kelly of Safeguard in Fort St. John, are not being utilized and that precious time is being wasted as fires burn while equipment sits idle.

With regard to public safety, we are imploring you to seek federal assistance. As we know, the federal government and military are able to not only assist with front line firefighting, but also to provide essential emergency response services such as evacuation support.

Finally, we have nothing but the highest regard and deep gratitude for the wildfire crews that are working tirelessly to protect our province. The work is dangerous and these incredible men and women are risking their own personal safety to protect others. That is why it is absolutely imperative that the proper resources and support be in place.

Dear Andrew.

I am writing in response to your letter of August 11 with respect to the developing wildfire situation in the province. Over the past 24 hours I have spoken directly with your colleagues Shirley Bond and John Rustad and would like to take this opportunity to reiterate some of the key points of those discussions. My colleague Doug Donaldson, Minister of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development has spoken to you and your colleagues and the leaders of many of the communities currently facing wildfire threats.

I would like to emphasize there are 3,460 dedicated and trusted wildfire

personnel working long hours every day to provide the best response possible to the 586 wildfires currently burning around the province. This work is dangerous and complex, and we are following the advice of these experts to ensure they have the resources and support required.

To that end, last week I asked senior officials in EMBC to prepare a draft order declaring a provincial state of emergency. My staff will recommend that I sign the order if and when they determine that it will aid our efforts to protect communities and deal with emerging fire threats.

Similarly, senior staff in Wildfire and EMBC have been in close contact with their federal counterparts for the past several days, and my deputy minister spoke to her federal counterpart late last evening. Together they have identified which personnel and aircraft resources the Federal Government could supply if Wildfire and EMBC staff recommend that I make such a request.

It is worth noting that while the provincial fire situation is still unsettled, the fire threat in other parts of Canada has decreased and as a result BC received additional 100 Mexican firefighters yesterday from Ontario.

In addition, EMBC is working to ensure communities have the supports they need to assist people through this emergency. We are coordinating with local governments through the Provincial Emergency Coordination Centre in Victoria and Provincial Regional Coordination Centres in Terrace, Prince George, Nelson and Kamloops. Emergency Social Services Reception Centres are currently activated in ten communities. The province is working with the RCMP and major population centres in central B.C. such as Kamloops, Kelowna and Prince George to ensure they stand prepared to coordinate mass evacuations should the need arise. We're grateful to these communities for their support, and for opening their homes and neighbourhoods to fellow British Columbians in need. Senior officials in EMBC and the Wildfire Service will be meeting again this afternoon to assess the situation across the province and I expect they will make recommendations regarding any additional actions they believe government needs to take to protect our citizens and our communities.
