EMBC UPDATE - November 06, 2017 AS OF 0700 HRS - ASSESSMENT

There were no new significant incidents in the province in the last 24 hours.

PROVINCIAL WEATHER

Today, sunny skies will dominate most of the province with a high pressure system holding in place. The only area seeing active weather will be the north coast, with a new Pacific storm approaching. Moisture from this storm will spread into the north coast later this afternoon, bringing moderate to heavy precipitation and rising freezing levels tonight.

The Pacific storm will continue to hit the North West on Tuesday, spreading precipitation southwards into the central coast including Bella Bella and Bella Coola. In the interior, there is a slight chance of flurries over the Kootenay - Boundary and Southern Columbia regions. Meanwhile, the south coast will stay mainly dry with some cloudy skies. By Wednesday, it is expected that the storm will begin to bring light precipitation to the south coast before it intensifies and begins to push inland to the southern interior.

WEATHER ALERTS

A Wind warning is issued for Haida Gwaii and North Vancouver Island. Strong southeasterly winds of 80 to 100 km/h will develop over Haida Gwaii near noon and spread to the exposed coastal sections of North Vancouver Island near midnight.

A Special air quality statement is issued for the Vanderhoof area, where elevated pollution levels are expected or are occurring.
