I write to advise that our proceeding has resulted in forfeiture of the above-noted property.

Any disputes to this administrative forfeiture proceeding must have been received by our office by 2019-07-22. As no dispute was received, forfeiture was deemed to occur on 2019-07-23. This letter serves as your notice that the Director completed all steps required by Part 3.1 of the Civil Forfeiture Act in relation to this property and it is now deemed forfeit to the Government. The property must be turned over to the Director as soon as practicable and steps for directing it to us are provided in this letter.

The cash should be handed over to GardaWorld at your next scheduled pick-up. Please complete a CIBC deposit slip for each deposit/bag/file. More slips can be obtained at any CIBC branch (ask the front desk staff or any teller for a book of commercial/business deposit slips) or from our office. Procedures are documented in the "Procedure for Transferring Cash to the CFO" document. GardaWorld's services are limited to pick-up from VPD and drop-off at CIBC Intra.

The Director will now arrange to liquidate this vehicle through BC Auction. Additionally, vehicle registration will be changed from the registered owner to the Province of BC. I confirm that we already have the vehicle at the AIR facility and that we have paid the towing fees and absorbed all other costs associated with storage of the vehicle during this proceeding. No further action is required on your part.

I appreciate this referral to our office and look forward to being of service to you and the Vancouver Police Department in the future.
