EMBC UPDATE - August 9, 2019 at 07:00 hrs

A small wildfire in East Sooke temporarily displaced residents in 5 homes and damaged a private deck last night. The fire was quickly extinguished by local fire crews.

A large wildfire burning near Tagish Lake in far northwestern BC has prompted an evacuation order for 4 properties and an alert for the Engineer Mine site. The fire is burning in a remote part of the Stikine region.

The Eagle Bluff wildfire near Oliver has grown to 2270 hectares, partly because of the success of controlled ignition operations. There is no change to alerts in Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen or Osoyoos Indian Band.

PROVINCIAL WEATHER

Today, high pressure continues its push across northeast BC and will produce showers along the Rockies, becoming more isolated as one moves west towards Terrace. There exists a risk of a thunderstorm in the afternoon for the central interior. Southern BC will remain sunny, with a small chance of showers and weak thunderstorms, particularly in the Kootenays. South coastal BC will see some sun as the stratus and fog burn off.

Saturday brings more widespread showers and thunderstorm activity to southern British Columbia while the northeast dries out. Showers and strong thunderstorms will develop over the southern interior while coastal areas should see just showers. General rainfall amounts will be 10mm but locally higher amounts can be achieved in thunderstorms. These showers will remain through Sunday where some areas could see upwards of 25mm of rain. Daytime highs cool down to the high teens to low twenties. Showers and below seasonal temperatures spread to northern B.C. by Monday.






