PSSG Priority Initiatives

Enforcement of illicit cannabis sales (CSU)

- Loosening restrictions on retail worker screening and delivery (LCRB)
- Farm-gate and direct delivery implementation (LCRB/LDB)
- On-site consumption and tourism policy options (Secretariat)

Challenges for Cannabis Growers

- High up-front costs and regulatory complexity of federal rules
- Lack of experience in regulated supply-chain
- Processing and quality assurance capacity bottleneck
- Prohibitive local government bylaws targeting cannabis agriculture
- Significant challenges with financial institutions and insurance firms
