

Floor Plan

- labels for each room
- patio(s)
- · liquor service bars
- · furniture layout
- kitchen
- stage
- · sound or DJ booth
- washrooms
- · stairs, entrances and exits


Plans must also show the physical separation (e.g. pony wall or full height wall) separating the proposed service area(s) from other licenses or unlicensed areas. If there is another licence, or another business (such as a retail store) at the same site, provide floor plans showing the other business in relation to the proposed LP establishment.

Occupant Load Calculation

Occupant Load is the maximum number of people (patrons plus staff) permitted in a service area. Contact the Local Government/First Nation to obtain an occupant load on your floor plan. The occupant load must be stamped or written, dated and signed on the floor plan by the appropriate authority.

This is in response to your submission of a structural change application which was received by the Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch (the Branch) on January 16, 2020.

Currently the LP licence #: 181998 has the following licensed areas:

- Person 01 = 150 persons (patrons and staff)
- Patio 1 = 0 (capacity taken from Person 01)
- Patio 2 = 0 (capacity taken from Person 01)

As per the information provided in your application, as well as the submitted floor plans, you have removed walls, made changes to the main entrance, added a stage, removed a storage area by the pool table and decreased the size of the liquor service bar.

As the proposed changes result in a net zero increase to the current LP capacity, formal local government consideration and public input is not required.

Although it was not stated in your application, Inspector Hedstrom identified the structural changes during routine inspection. A structural change application was required to address the compliance deficiency.

Based on my review of the floor plan and proposed layout I am satisfied that it complies with statutory and Liquor and Cannabis Regulation policy provisions. I have enclosed a copy of the floor plan which has been stamped and authorized with Approved in Principle (AIP).

This AIP is subject to the following conditions:

- All existing terms and conditions on the LP liquor licence will remain in effect.

Although the renovations have already occurred, this approval in principle does not imply final approval. The request should be accompanied by evidence demonstrating that the delay is beyond the control of the applicant. 




