Re: Request for a Special Investigation pursuant to section 44(1)(b) of the Police Act

Further to our conversations on this matter during late February and March 3, 2023, I am writing to confirm that the Alberta Serious Incident Response Team (ASIRT) will assume conduct of an investigation into allegations related to historical sexual assaults committed in Prince George by members of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police

Pursuant to section 44 (1) (b) of the *Police Act* of British Columbia, I have ordered an independent investigation of these matters. As discussed, these incidents allegations and the subsequent responses will form the focus of ASIRT's investigation.

As discussed, my office will serve as the contact for ASIRT in this matter related to:

- Assuming all costs associated with this investigation;
- Any additional assistance and/or coordination required by ASIRT to complete its investigation, including facilitating access to contact persons in the BC Prosecution Service, 'E- Division' RCMP and other organizations requested by ASIRT; and,
- Other assistance that may be requested by ASIRT.
