Good afternoon all,

As I am reviewing the survey data I wanted to send you a sample of some of the written feedback we are receiving as the tip of the iceberg.

- All reservations have been cancelled, no new bookings have occurred July revenue as a percentage of last year at 36% to-date
- We have had cancellation every single day since July 9
- We were 90% booked for July and all have cancelled – restaurant & bar revenue is 25% of seasonal average
- We have never seen this many cancellations.
- Close to 100 cancellations so far and still getting about 10 per day – other services revenue down over 50% and occupancy less than 30%
- People are cancelling August already and won't wait
- 100% cancelled
- 100% cancelled for July and 85% cancelled for August – we had 95% of July booked
- Losing \$1600 per day
- Losing \$1500 per day
- 95% cancellation – 5% is evacuees staying with us at reduced rates

Figures are coming in as well - will get more detail for you later this week.

Amber, FYI earlier this week I stood in for Recovery on a conference call involving Cariboo Regional District, Williams Lake, 100 Mile, Wells and a few other Las. While the purpose of the call was to discuss needs for a recovery manager position, a fair bit of discussion revolved around economic impacts. A quick summary of what I passed on to the NEA Recovery Team:

CRD: Observing large economic impact due to road closures and conditions; observing many tourism operators closing earlier in the year than usual. Every type of business has felt impacts. Two of the largest festival events were cancelled on short notice, further magnifying losses (e.g. Billy Barker Days); Some impacts are due to Wildfire operations (e.g. Sky Festival cancelled as Wildfire took over airport). Hotels and restaurants in areas where ESS operations were underway may have enjoyed lower vacancy rates.

Williams Lake – many impacts to business. Noted many staff who evacuated town did not return – a larger factor in lower wage and skill jobs. (I'm aware this was noted in Fort MacMurray AB too).

Wells – no direct impacts due to fire but indirect business impact sizable – some business reporting 70-80% declines.

Participants agreed the impacts in urban areas are quite different than rural; a feeling that rural Cariboo may have suffered a transformational change due to impacts on timber and ranching.

Hey Erin,

Thanks for the call – DBC has pulled some of the following high level information on impacts to date. Is this the kind of thing you are looking for? This information in the BECDA hotline (so is not tourism specific) but we could aggregate some of the data from the tourism surveys if needed – though we won't be able to get that to you tomorrow.

The top immediate needs are:

- Access to cashflow/capital expressed by 70% of callers
- Understanding what immediate and future support will be (resources, programs, grants, loans) 53%
- Assistance with operating expenses by 41% of callers
- Assistance with marketing to get customers back by 24% of callers
- 44% indicating that their insurance doesn't cover for business losses

In addition:

There has been a s.21 direct loss to Barkerville Heritage Trust; s.21 loss to the merchants who operate businesses within the heritage town; and approx. s.21 regionally just in business to Heritage Sites. (Please note that these numbers have not been approved for public consumption and are approximate).

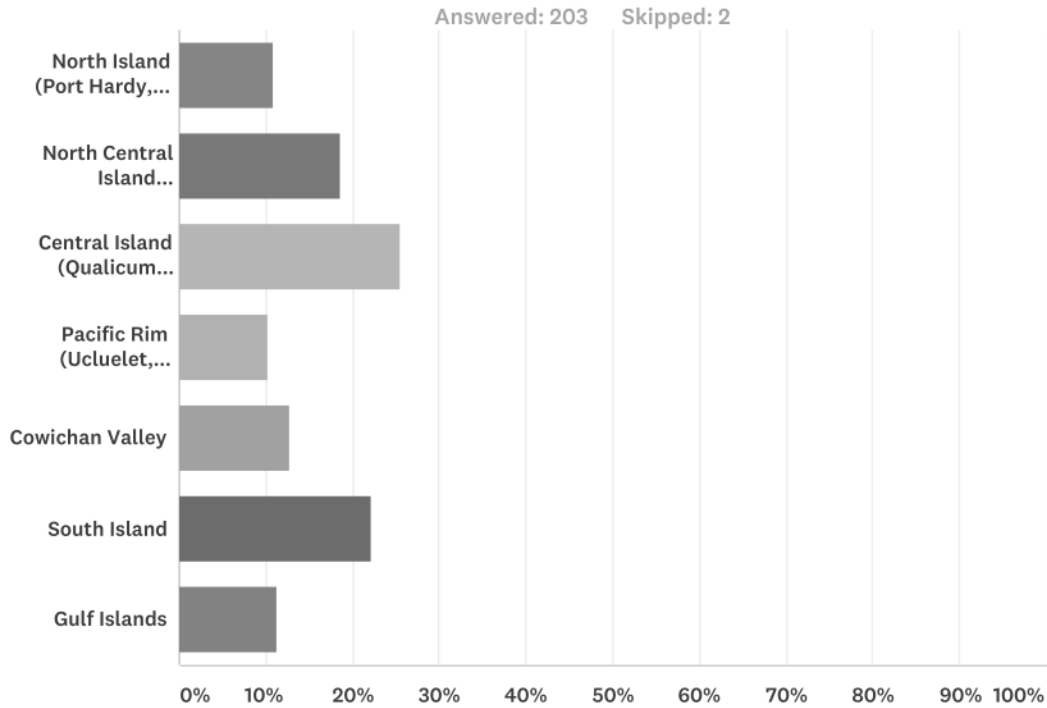

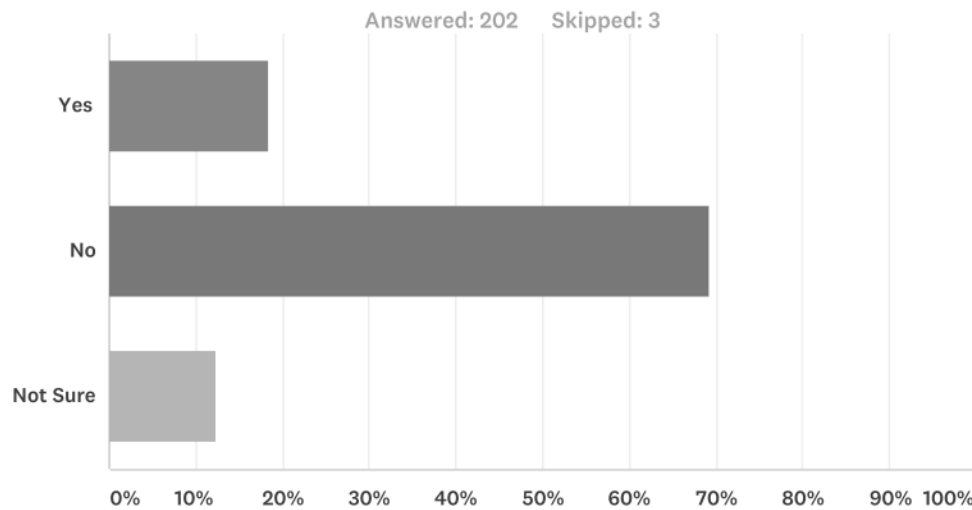
