





New information is just coming in about there being a potential protest outside the 9am or 6pm events. This is what I know:

- Food and beverage workers at the Edge Water Casino were unionised.
- With the transfer of the Casino to Parq Vancouver, food & beverage positions are no longer unionized.
- Food and beverage employees were given the option to change jobs to other union positions at the Parq Vancouver casino.
- Overall, the new casino has more union positions at Parq Vancouver than it did at Edge Water.

Here is the background that I have on the issue thus far:

- In February 2016, Edgewater informed Unifor and all Edgewater food service employees that when Parq Vancouver opened, all food and beverage functions outside of the hotels would be managed by a third party, as the scope and scale of Parq's food & beverage program needed to be realized and managed by a recognized expert. Parq Vancouver includes eight separate food & beverage venues, each of which is a unique, stand-alone facility catering to the dining and beverage needs and expectations of Parq's diverse customer base.
- In June 2017, Parq Vancouver announced that Blau Restaurant Associates LP, a
  highly respected restauranteur, would manage the Parq food and beverage
  venues. Founded by Elizabeth Blau and her husband, Chef Kim Canteenwalla,
  the Blau group are generally acknowledged as being the catalyst for the
  "celebrity chef" direction top tier restaurants have taken over the last decade.
- All Edgewater food & beverage employees have been offered the choice of either transitioning to BA Restaurant Holdings LTD or staying in the collective bargaining unit and transitioning to casino or customer service positions.
- 50 of the 84 Edgewater food & beverage union employees have decided to work for Elizabeth Blau, as it will give them extensive opportunities to learn the restaurant business through exposure to a wide spectrum of cuisines created by top tier chefs and culinary experts, with excellent opportunities for advancement. The other F+B employees were internal transfers to the casino or resigned.
- Parq Casino will have 700 employees in the collective bargaining unit, an increase of 121 union members over the Edgewater Casino.
- Parq Vancouver will employ 1,694 full time equivalent associates, which
  equates to approximately 2,078 full time and part time jobs, with a projected
  annual payroll of approximately \$85M.

<u>.</u> Yakashiro's interest and concern lies with the ways in which the Japanese Canadian internment is discussed and historized, using her family's internment in Sandon as a geographical space which holds layers of historical injustice and / or trauma.

Mr. Stanger-Ross is a former Chair of the <u>Canadian Committee on Migration</u>, <u>Ethnicity</u>, and <u>Transnationalism</u>, which is affiliated with the Canadian Historical Association, and founded UVIC's Committee for Urban Studies, which initiated the interdisciplinary lecture series, <u>The City Talks</u>. Since founding Landscapes of Injustice, Stanger-Ross has edited a book, <u>Witness to Loss: Race, Culpability, and Memory in the Dispossession of Japanese Canadians</u> (McGill Queens University Press, 2017), with Pamela Sugiman, and written a number of articles, including, <u>"Promises of Law: The Unlawful Dispossession of Japanese Canadians,"</u> Osgoode Hall Law Journal 54, 3 (2017), with Eric Adams, and "My Land is worth a million dollars': How Japanese Canadians contested their dispossession in the 1940s" *Law and History Review* 35, 3 (2017), with Nicholas Blomley.
