As discussed, here is a brief overview of the 45<sup>th</sup> <u>Siggraph</u>, Conference on Computer Graphics and Interactive Techniques which is being held in Vancouver August 12-16<sup>th</sup>.

SIGGRAPH 2018, which attracts 15,000 attendees from around the world, is a five-day conference into the latest innovations in CG, Animation, VR, Games, Digital Art, Mixed Reality and Emerging Technologies. There is also the business symposium, which Creative BC and the Province are the key sponsors of (\$50,000). The Business Symposium, organized by SIGGRAPH takes place on Saturday August 11<sup>th</sup> and Sunday August 12<sup>th</sup>. The theme of the business symposium this year is exploring the intersection of Creativity and Technology. The audience, of about 200 VIPs will get to learn from feature speakers from multiple industries and backgrounds who will explore the intersection of technology, creativity and business.

There will also be programming for the international delegations during the conference that Creative BC and JTT will be funding (\$25K Creative BC and \$10K JTT – tbc). This will include 4 information/networking sessions, a networking reception, local company site visits (tbc) and a b2b program.
