The Town Hall with the staff concerning lay-offs was held all day yesterday at PavCo, and by all accounts went as smoothly as could be hoped. The union were helpful as were the middle management in the whole process. It helped that members of the Board with particular experience in labour matters also were consulted by senior staff and had useful suggestions.

Here is Rehana's brief summary which may be of assistance to you:

The overwhelming response from our leaders has been that the staff was very appreciative of the time, effort and consideration put into both the plan itself and communication of the process, particularly the town hall. Given the challenging circumstances this is the best we could have hoped for. We will continue to monitor and check in with staff over the next few days as things sink in and the staff have more questions.



This presentation has been made to Bauer Hockey, The NHL, Canadian Tire, Scotia Bank and a handful of medical professionals. The common response has been "WOW", "you are way ahead of anyone else we've spoken to, including the sport governing bodies".

After reviewing BC's 4 Phase approach it looks like Phase 2 anticipates recreation and sports to come back. We understand that there have been a handful of ice rinks in the lower mainland that have received approval on a very limited basis of operation. While this is a good start, we would like you to consider a new model for our sport. We have adapted some of the concepts that you have reviewed with the NHL scenario, so this is why we would like you to consider our proposal and why we would like

to present quickly to you and your staff given it's merit and our position as one of the industry leaders in recreational sports facility operations in Canada. Our Chief Operating Officer spoke to Trent Carroll from the Vancouver Canucks and he suggested that we reach out to you personally to hear our proposal.

We do not feel that hockey and or ice sports as we have known them can stay the same for the foreseeable future and that they must change to adapt to this new reality with the COVID19 virus living amongst us for an undetermined period of time. We have developed a safe and innovative model that will enable ice sports facilities to return to as early as this summer using an innovative game format, zoning system, traffic management, space utilization and strict safety protocols. Our industry partners all believe that this model has what it takes and that it's worth pursuing with you. We have incorporated the most recent Work Safe BC guidelines into our plan.

My senior management team has reached out to the BC Recreation and Parks Association (Rebecca Tunnacliffe) as we are aware from what the Premier mentioned in his speech this past May 6th that BCRPA have been tasked to look at how to bring back recreation facilities across the province. We have reached out to both BCRPA and to Via Sports. My senior leaders have had great conversations with Via Sports, but it looks like they will not be providing approvals to the PSO's, but will be up to the sport organizations to follow Via Sports guidelines and each PSO, club, etc. will need to have their board approve their return to sports. Since we are not a municipal facility or a PSO, we do not fall under either of these two organizations mandates. However our company has a huge interest in hockey with the largest Adult Hockey league in the world with over 65,000 players.

Currently Canlan Ice Sports operate 5 facilities in BC with Scotia Barn (formerly Burnaby 8 Rinks – home of Skate Canada) as our flagship facility. We also manage the Recreation and Parks department for the City of Armstrong and the Township of Spallumcheen and manage a facility on behalf of the Cariboo Regional District in 100 Mile House. This is why we are approaching you directly as we do have a vested interest in all areas of sport both for the private and public sector.

Shortly after we closed our facilities across North America on March 13th, we felt it was important to reach out to other private sector operators in the recreation and sport industry to discuss how best to bring back our sport and our businesses. I currently chair this industry leaders' group and we have been meeting weekly with updates on each province and state where we have been impacted. In Canada we operate in British Columbia, Saskatchewan, Manitoba and Ontario. So, we

have been monitoring very closely each province's reopening plans to see how we fit into each scenario. We have completed detailed scenario planning for all of our business segments. We own and operate ice rinks, multisport facilities, restaurants, retail stores and have over 48 tenants in our buildings from fitness facilities, Skate Canada, doctor offices to physio clinics and more.

Ms. Minister, we would like the opportunity to meet with you and your colleagues to present what we have put together to bring back our national sport in a

safe manner. Your time is precious, and your task is monumental. Our plan is sound, well thought out, innovative and critical for the spirit of Canadians. For those reasons and many more, we feel that it is essential that we be permitted to share it with you at your earliest convenience.

We do hope you will give us an opportunity to present our plan so we can offer hope to our dedicated employees that are on the sidelines wanting to get back to what they are so passionate about. We have had our General Managers reach out to many of our customers to see how they are doing and to gauge their level of interest in returning this summer. Overwhelmingly, our customers are ready to come back and play the game that they love. They said they will do whatever it takes, from PPE, testing, physical distancing, etc. as long as it is safe, and we have the approval to do so. They told us they just want to get active again and play the sport they are so passionate about.

Thanks again for your time this morning.

On the separate subject of covid 19 impacts on tourism, I did want to mention a couple of points you may want to know.

As a leading member of the Discovery Island Marine Tourism Group, and tourism chair for the Discovery Island Tourism/Forestry Working group, I'm pretty well connected and up to speed on the tourism sector in this (our) area.

If anyone thought the Western Forest Products strike was hard on the local economy, that may pale in comparison to a complete tourism shutdown which appears to be where we're headed. In my opinion, the Outer Islands tourism economy is worth an estimated \$50 million to the Campbell River area alone—that would include the likes of Coast Mountain, Discovery Islands Lodge, Spirit of the West, Mothership Adventures, Sonora Resort, Hollyhock and many others including 50 or more B&B's, along with 6-8 marinas scattered though out the islands. Combined with impacts to companies and businesses operating out of Campbell River, I'd estimate losses at well over 100 million dollars to the local economy over the next 3-4 months. This figure could be much higher...it's hard to say. Whale and bear watching tours alone account for more than 10 million dollars in revenue alone. Then there's the lost employment—probably over 1,000 people. For most of us, the season is already a complete write-off. Of course, I'm not able to factor in tourism operations and lodges outside the immediate area. We might be looking at total losses in the North Island region of more than a quarter billion dollars. I don't think I'm being sensational with my estimates.

I'm not expecting you or the government to do anything about this. I just thought you'd be interested in knowing.

Maybe when the dust settles on all this, we can have

Hello Claire,

Thanks again for your time this morning.

On the separate subject of covid 19 impacts on tourism, I did want to mention a couple of points you may want to know.

As a leading member of the Discovery Island Marine Tourism Group, and tourism chair for the Discovery Island Tourism/Forestry Working group, I'm pretty well connected and up to speed on the tourism sector in this (our) area.

If anyone thought the Western Forest Products strike was hard on the local economy, that may pale in comparison to a complete tourism shutdown which appears to be where we're headed. In my opinion, the Outer Islands tourism economy is worth an estimated \$50 million to the Campbell River area alone—that would include the likes of Coast Mountain, Discovery Islands Lodge, Spirit of the West, Mothership Adventures, Sonora Resort, Hollyhock and many others including 50 or more B&B's, along with 6-8 marinas scattered though out the islands. Combined with impacts to companies and businesses operating out of Campbell River, I'd estimate losses at well over 100 million dollars to the local economy over the next 3-4 months. This figure could be much higher...it's hard to say. Whale and bear watching tours alone account for more than 10 million dollars in revenue alone. Then there's the lost employment—probably over 1,000 people. For most of us, the season is already a complete write-off. Of course, I'm not able to factor in tourism operations and lodges outside the immediate area. We might be looking at total losses in the North Island region of more than a quarter billion dollars. I don't think I'm being sensational with my estimates.

I'm not expecting you or the government to do anything about this. I just thought you'd be interested in knowing.

Attached please find our BCRFA Blueprint for the Reopening of In-Restaurant Dining. We are honoured that you have given our industry the privilege and responsibility to come to you with our innovative ideas in this time of great change.

COVID-19 has had dramatic impacts on our industry. As the province's third largest sector by number of employees, the impact is widespread. Our operators are challenged but resilient and determined to provide the high quality dining experience in the future that we have come to be known for across BC. In a short timeframe, we gathered a group of more than 50 industry leaders to come to one table to talk about realistic ideas that can be implemented across a broad spectrum of operation styles. While every solution will not apply to every operator, the best practices and processes we outline are intended for the whole and reflect our deep commitment to building on staff and public trust.

This is our initial document. Your expertise and expectations are the key to making this turn into a living document for operators. We have several subcommittees working starting today on particular processes and business areas and how we can achieve enhanced standards for this unusual time.
