Thank you for your team's ongoing engagement with Ministry of Tourism, Arts, Culture and Sport (Ministry) staff regarding the exploratory discussions between the Canadian Olympic Committee (COC) and Canadian Paralympic Committee (CPC) with local First Nations, municipalities, and venue operators on Canada and British Columbia (B.C.) bidding to host the 2030 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games. We appreciate being informed of, and contributing to, dialogue that serves to bring communities together to the benefit of our province.

The Ministry recognizes that as the franchise holders of the Olympic and Paralympic Games, the mandates of the COC and CPC are to promote sport in Canada and include assessment of potential hosting opportunities of the Olympic and Paralympic Games.

We are acquainted with the new bidding and hosting process that has been implemented by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) and understand that in order to adequately assess the feasibility of having the Winter Games return to Canada and B.C. it is necessary to validate your work in the context of this process. The next step of this work, which the Provincial Government supports, is to engage in non-committal, non-edition specific 'Continuous Dialogue' with the IOC. We also understand that you will be following Canada's federal framework for hosting major international sport events as you explore this opportunity, which sees relevant domestic parties contribute to the development of concept in a meaningful way.

Good Morning

I hope this email finds you well.

As discussed recently, an IOC technical team will be visiting next week as part of the IOC's potential future host assessment process. There were several [news articles](#) about a similar visit to Salt Lake City this week, and we anticipate

there will be some news around a visit to British Columbia following previously scheduled media briefing that we undertook this morning. It is important to note that the same small group of technical experts will be visiting both locations, and the visit does not include any elected members of the IOC Future Host Commission. They have been clear that this not a political visit, should be kept small, and focus on technical review of the project and venues.

Transparency is an important component of the project overall so we will be provide media with statements if requested to ensure everyone understands where this visit fits in the IOC's process. We are also discussing the potential of reaching out to targeted media who have previously connected with us to ensure they understand the nature of this visit.

For context, below is how the IOC describes a technical visit:

"As part of the non-committal continuous dialogue and the collaborative new approach to future host elections, the IOC makes available to potential hosts a range of services. Such services include an IOC technical site visit to assist potential hosts and their National Olympic Committees, to develop their Games projects. The technical visit will also provide the future Host Commission with an update on the future games project."
