I won't be there on Thursday or Friday.

My comments:

- 1. When the highway needs to be closed for eastbound traffic at the Ft Steele interchange there needs to be two flaggers there one to direct traffic to Ft Steele, and the other needs to positioned so as to prevent drivers from Hwy 93/95 looping around under the interchange bridge and thinking they can keep heading east.
- 2. Without causing traffic congestion at the Ft Steele end of Wardner-Ft Steele a flagger can not stop all traffic at that location just to find out if they are heading east or west.
- 3. The tow company should be better prepared when the RCMP gives the okay to start recovery. They certainly could have been escorted to the site by MoTI or MEK before the analyst was done so that there would be no doubt as to what would be needed to quickly do the recovery and clean-up when cleared to do so.
- 4. The flaggers were sent to the site with an insufficient number and type of signs. For example, at Ft Steele the flagger would have liked to put up a Detour with arrow sign, but he didn't have one.
