VC73 RESPONDED ROUTINE TO A REPORTED STRUCTURE FIRE, VPD O/S WITH A SUSPECT WHO HAD BARRICADED IN THE ROOM # 218 OF 2111 MAIN ST, (CITY CENTER MOTOR HOTEL) \$.15

s.15 CAPTAIN VE03 JOHNSON I/C, VB01 COROLIVE. THIS STRUCTURE IS A 2 STOREY TYPE 5 WOOD FRAME HOTEL WITH 2 WINGS / 68 ROOMS. THE INVOLVED STRUCTURE IS SITUATED WITH THE OFFICE ON THE SOUTH SIDE AND THE ROOMS RUNNING TO THE NORTH. THE OTHER WING NOT AFFECTED RUNS EAST/WEST. (REFERRED TO BY STAFF AS THE NORTH BUILDING) AND IS PRIMARILY CINDER BLOCK .NOTE THE AFFECTED ROOM # 218 HAS A SOUTH EXPOSURE TO # 216 AND DOWNSTAIRS, #118 & # 116 DIVIDED BY A CINDER BLOCK FIRE STOP TO THE OTHER SUITES IN THE SAME WING . THE OFFICE AREA AT THE SOUTH END HAS AN UNDERGROUND BASEMENT . FIRE PROTECTION CONSISTS OF AN ALARM SYSTEM AND NO SPRINKLER PROTECTION WITH MANUAL OPERATED EXTINGUISHERS. THE INTERVIEWS AND INVESTIGATION REVEALED THAT s.15,s.22 s.15,s.22

s.15,s.22 AT 0838 HRS A FIRE ALARM WENT ACTIVE AND THE MANAGER NOTIFIED THE CONSTABLE VPD # 1678 TRIED TO BREAK INTO THE ROOM # 218 BUT COULD ONLY OPEN THE DOOR APPROX ONE FOOT.. HE WAS ALERTED THAT THE SUSPECT WAS ATTEMPTING TO ESCAPE OUT THE WINDOW ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE OF THE HOTEL BY VPD # 2873 . HE RAN BACK DOWN THE STAIRS AND AROUND TO ASSIST IN APPREHENDING THE SUSPECT CLIMBING OUT THE WINDOW LEAVING THE DOOR AJAR WITH THE FIRE VENTED ENTRY POINT AND EXIT POINT AT THE OPEN WINDOW IN THE ROOM. HE LATER RETURNED TO TRY & EXTINGUISH THE FIRE WITH AN EXTINGUISHER BUT AGAIN COULD NOT MAKE ENTRY. FIRE CREWS ARRIVED SHORTLY AFTER WITH VE03 COMPANY FIRST ON SCENE. F.F HOOPER STATED HE WAS ONE OF THE FIRST FIRE FIGHTERS TO ACCESS THE ROOM AFTER REPEATED ATTEMPTS ON THE DOOR. HE DISCOVERED HEAVY THICK BLACK SMOKE WITH THE ROOM CONTENTS ON FIRE UP AGAINST THE INSIDE OF THE DOOR. FIRE CREWS WORKED QUICKLY TO EXTINGUISH THE ROOM CONTENTS ON FIRE INCLUDING THE BED MATTRESS AND OTHER FURNITURE USED TO BARRICADE THE DOOR.( FIRE HAD QUICKLY CONSUMED THESE CONTENTS)( HOTEL OWNER INFO TO FOLLOW ) MINOR INJURIES REPORTED BY VPD TO AND TO THE SUSPECT LISTED EARLIER \$.22 A LATER s.15.s.22

BURN PATTERNS DISCOVERED BEHIND THE DOOR RM # 218, ON THE CARPETED FLOOR AND THE CARBON DEPOSITS IN THE ROOM SUPPORT THIS OPINION. ( SEE PICTURE SET OF DETAILS). THE MINI RAE HYDROCARBON DETECTOR WAS USED WITH NO SIGNIFICANT READINGS FOUND, HOW EVER GIVEN THE TIME AND STRUCTURAL FIRE FIGHTING ACTIVITY THIS IS NOT SURPRISING. THE BUTANE REFILL CARTRIDGE WAS ALSO FOUND AND IDENTIFIED IN THE ROOM ALONG WITH AN EMPTY PACKAGE OF CIGARETTES ALTHOUGH NO IGNITING OBJECT COULD BE FOUND DURING THE INVESTIGATION. NO OTHER COMPETENT IGNITION SOURCES WERE FOUND IN THE AREA OF ORIGIN BEHIND THE DOOR OR SURROUNDING AREA. THE PROBABLE CAUSE OF THIS FIRE IS THE INITIAL FUEL BEING THE TOILET PAPER AND BUTANE INCENDIARY, s.22 REFILL CYLINDER USED, HOWEVER THE IGNITING OBJECT WAS NOT FOUND. (LIKELY SMOKERS MATERIAL) EITHER REMOVED BY THE SUSPECT OR DISCARDED. DAMAGE TO ROOM #218 IS EXTENSIVE, ROOM #216 ALSO SUSTAINED CONSIDERABLE SMOKE DAMAGE WITH # 118 ALSO SUSTAINING HEAVY WATER DAMAGE POSSIBLE WATER DAMAGE TO ROOM # 116. THE HOTEL MANGER POLO YANG 604-876-7166 WAS ADVISED OF THE SAFETY AND SECURITY CONCERNS IN AND OUTSIDE THE ROOM . HE WAS ALSO ADVISED NOT TO ENTER OR ACCESS THE AREA WITH OUT CHECKING WITH VPD DUE TO AN ONGOING INVESTIGATION. SCENE LEFT IN CARE OF VPD AND AN ORDER ISSUED TO POLO YANG MANAGER TO HAVE THE ALARM SYSTEM RESTORED TO PROPER WORKING ORDER AND MAINTAIN A
