- 2) One copy is retained by the Senior Traffic Engineer.
- 3) Three copies are sent to the police having jurisdiction over the zone.
- 4) Two copies are sent to the Regional Director, Highways, who in turn sends them to the District Highways Manager. The District Highways Manager gives the date on which the signs were erected, signs the forms, returns one form to the Senior Traffic Engineer and retains one form for his files.
