Hi Shawn,

Paper Plates with full color are very \$\$\$\$.. as you will pay for each color- extra- and the costs add up fast.

I have **never done** paper plates with a picture, so I will need to research our vendors to see who and if, this can be done and get you costs.

The most common type of plate would be white plastic coated paper plate- 9 inch, with one color text : 1 line , and the order would be 1,000,2000 or 5000...of the plates are a line of text, price runs about .65 - .55 each plate.

Most of the time with Swag, you want folks to **keep the item** and take with, thus the marketing continues.

Paper Plates: in my opinion ,since they get thrown out, have a very limited marketing exposure.

- A key chain is something folks would use over and over again.

This is a key chain flashlight and stylus that can be imprinted full color in the center of the item

The imprint area is 1 inch x ¾ inch ..small but a great product.

-
- Delivery on this type of thing is 4 weeks, so we will need to get moving.

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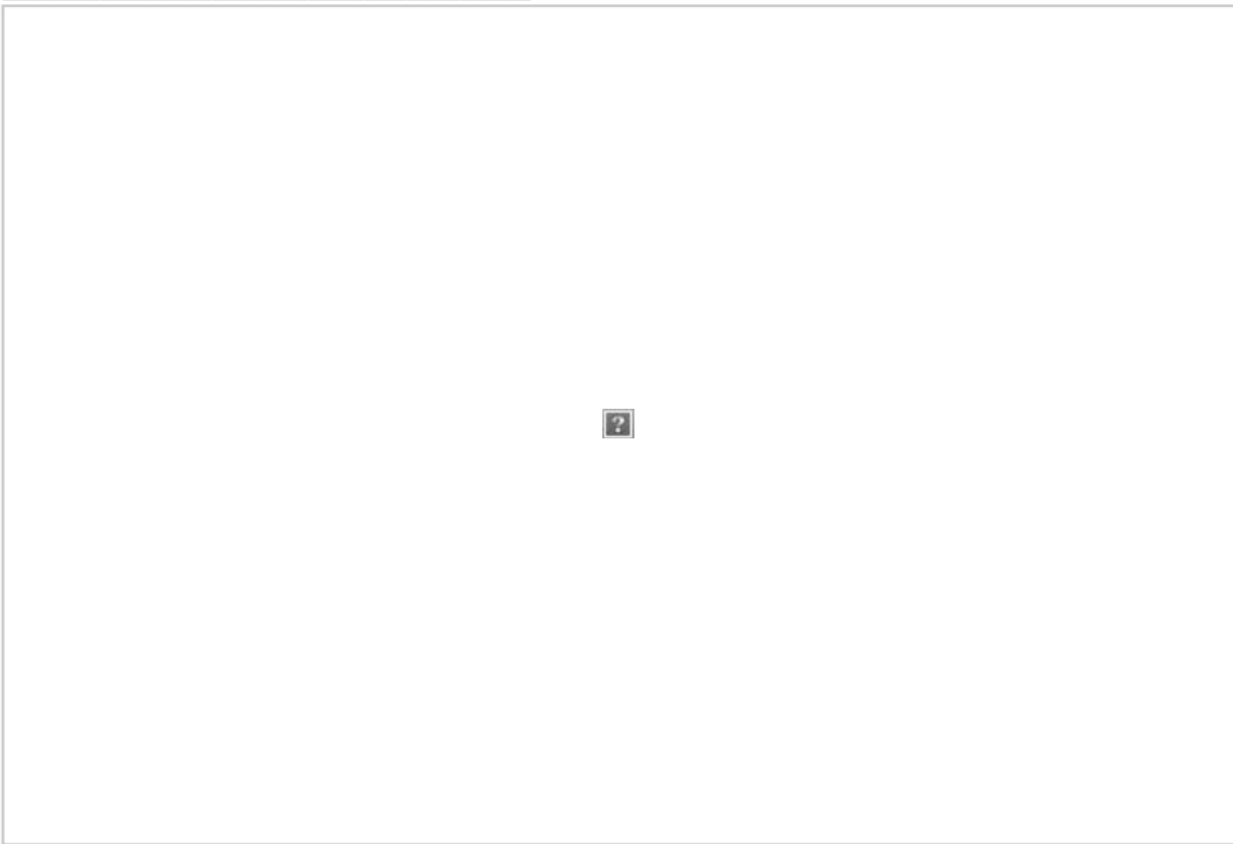
