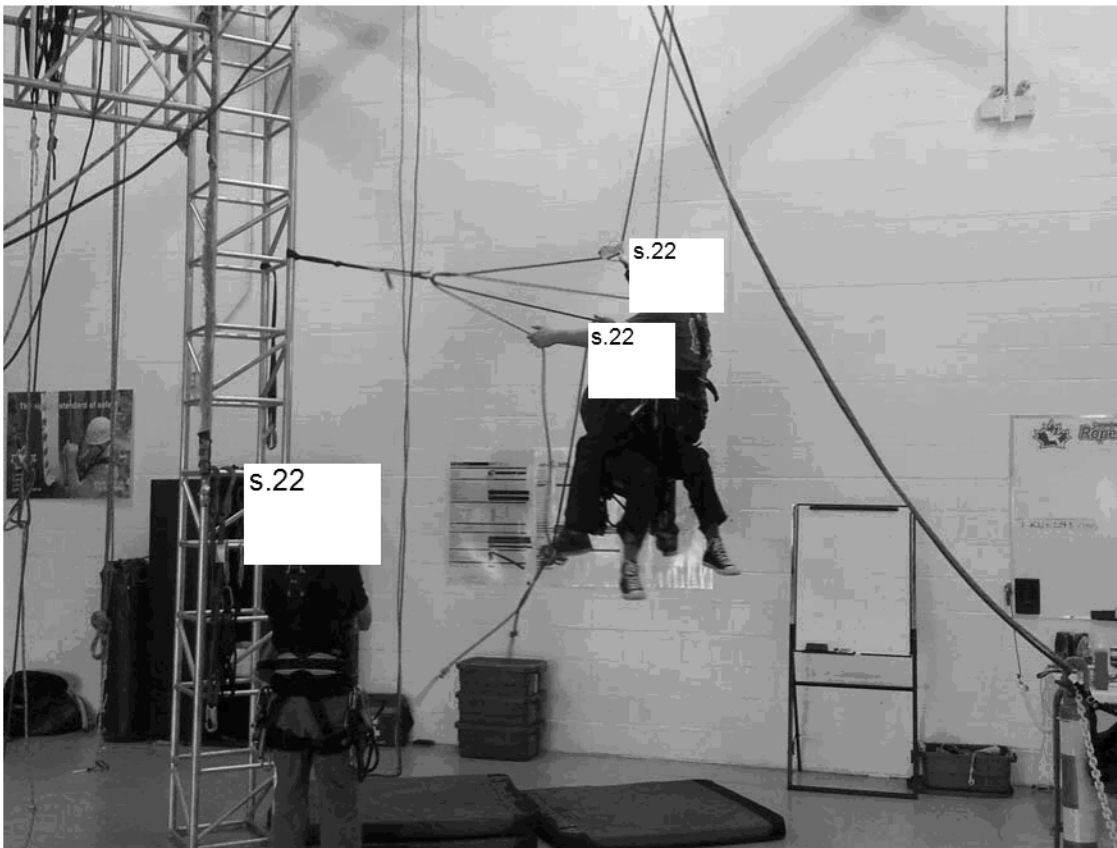

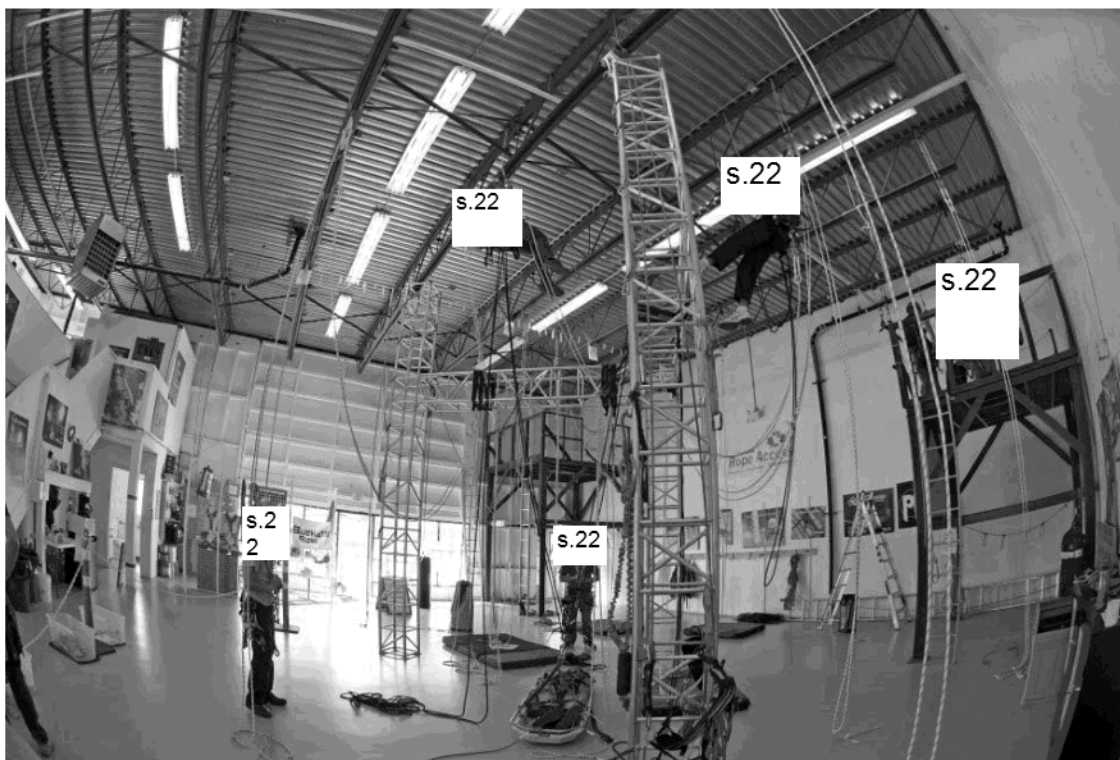

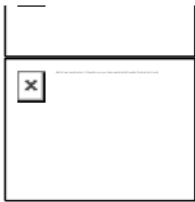

SUMMARY:

- The Ministry has received an unsolicited proposal for the private adventure tourism opportunity involving the Lions Gate Bridge.
- The proponent has worked with the Ministry and key stakeholders to satisfy all technical requirements surrounding the safety and feasibility of such an opportunity.
- The Ministry is issuing a Notice of Intent to inform any other potential vendors that the Ministry is considering an exclusive use license for the Lions Gate Bridge for a pilot of proposed opportunity.

- The Ministry will evaluate any submissions received in response to the Notice of Intent on the merits of the objections raised and their applicable to the opportunity being proposed. If required, the Ministry will convene a meeting with any vendors deemed necessary.
- The Notice of Intent posted on BC Bid is used to insure a fair and transparent approach in working with unsolicited proposals for exclusive use of public property.

BACKGROUND:

In May 2015, the Lower Mainland District office was approached by Legendworthy Quest Inc. (the 'proponent') with a proposal to develop and operate an adventure tourism business using the Lions Gate Bridge. The Lions Gate Bridge Climb adventure would include guiding paying customers to the top of the bridge towers^{s.21}

s.21 Inside the towers, the existing ladders would provide an opportunity to climb up and down the tower with various viewpoint stops in between.

District staff has worked in conjunction with the proponent to identify the requirements and process in considering such a proposal. Many of the technical considerations have been addressed to the satisfaction of the Ministry, including the design of a new commercially-viable fall arrest system inside of the bridge towers. There are no operational or maintenance concerns with this proposal, and our Bridge Engineers have reviewed and confirmed that the Lions Gate Bridge Structure is not compromised or significantly altered in any way.

Ministry has requested that the proponent complete an Emergency Response Plan, which will be shared with emergency responders once the Vancouver Parks Board (and the City) has approved the proposal. We have not initiated any reach out to any media ourselves. If any other major outlets approach us, I will keep you in the loop. I hesitate to dismiss large media since we intend to establish and maintain meaningful relationships with them to promote the attraction.

It's been a very intense couple of days full of a cold roll out we were not prepared for. We have not been promoting the attraction directly (as in collecting email addresses, or directing people to websites, or social media) but we have been actively ensuring that the public understand that this is not a finalized deal, and that MoTI is following established procedures for public access to opportunities.

We are now in a highly undesirable position of waiting for proposals to roll in by March 17th, and our decision to ensure an accurate MoTI message of being open to receive proposals is not really in our best interest. However, we feel certain that it would be difficult if not impossible for someone to demonstrate a superior capability for operating a bridge climb since there is no one in North America who has such experience. Unfortunately this public attention has also potentially impacted the Parks Board meeting. It is difficult for Parks Staff to re-assure Parks Board Members that this is most likely awarded to SkyHugger when the Minister
