Remarks:

ON THE DAY OF THE FIRE THE FIRE CHIEF ARRIVED FIRST ON SCENE. THE FIRE CHIEF WAS MET BY THE PROPERTY REPRESENTATIVE s.22 WHO STATED 'THE FIRE WAS OUT'. FURTHER INVESTIGATION PROVED THE FIRE WAS IN FACT STILL BURNING. FIRST IN FIREFIGHTING CREWS DESCRIBED THE FIRE INSIDE THE LAUNDRY ROOM AS: IN THE FLOOR AREA, MID-WAY IN THE LAUNDRY ROOM ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE WHERE THE WALL MEETS THE FLOOR. CREWS THEN PULLED DRYWALL AND FLOORING IN THAT AREA TO ATTEMPT TO EXTINGUISH IT. CREWS THEN EXITED THE LAUNDRY ROOM AND ENTERED THE SUITE LOCATED ADJACENT TO THE LAUNDRY ROOM. CREWS OBSERVED SMOKE AND FLAMES IN THE SUITE. THEY CUT A SECTION OUT OF THE FLOOR, PULLED DRYWALL OFF THE WALL AND CEILING AREA IN ATTEMPT TO EXTINGUISH THE VISIBLE FLAMES. CREWS THEN RETURNED TO THE LAUNDRY ROOM AND REMOVED MORE AREAS OF DRYWALL AND FLOORING IN AN ATTEMPT TO STOP THE SPREAD OF FIRE. COMMAND SENT CREWS TO THE FLOORS ABOVE THE AREA OF ORIGIN. THE 2ND FLOOR CREWS REPORTED TO COMMAND THAT THEY OBSERVED HEAVY SMOKE AND HEAT. IT APPEARED TO HAVE EXTENDED UP AND WAS NOW CONTINUING TO BURN IN THE WALLS & FLOOR AREA. TACTICS OF FIRE SUPPRESSION WERE IMPLEMENTED TO EXTINGUISH IT. AFTER THE FIRE WAS EXTINGUISHED, DUE TO HEAVY STRUCTURAL DAMAGE, ENTRY TO THE NORTH WING OF THE BUILDING WAS DEEMED UNSAFE BY A STRUCTURAL ENGINEER. A COMPANY WAS HIRED (NOT BY THE CITY), TO REMOVE THE 3 FLOORS ON THE NORTH WING WITH AN EXCAVATOR. WHEN MCKEOWN (INVESTIGATOR), ARRIVED ON THE DAY WHEN THE INVESTIGATION WAS TO TAKE PLACE, IT WAS IDENTIFIED THAT THE ROOM AND CONTENTS OF THE LAUNDRY ROOM (AREA OF ORIGIN), WERE NOT ABLE TO BE SALVAGED. THE EXCAVATOR OPERATOR REMOVED ALL THE CHARRED AND CRUSHED MATERIAL FROM THE AREA. THE INVESTIGATOR TOOK A COUPLE PICTURES OF THE BARE CEMENT 4' CRAWL SPACE WALLS THAT REMAINED. DARREN BERG, EXECUTIVE GENERAL ADJUSTER FOR CUNNINGHAM LINDSEY, SPOKE TO SPOKE TO S.22 AND ANOTHER TENANT FROM THE BUILDING WHO GAVE HIM A RECOUNT OF THE INITIAL STAGES OF THE EVENT FROM BEFORE FIRE CREWS HAD ARRIVED. THE TENANT HAD OBSERVED SMOKE AND FLAMES IN THE LAUNDRY ROOM AFTER s.2 HAD INITIALLY SPOKE TO s.22 AND HAD ASKED \$.2 WHAT WAS HAPPENING. S. MCKEOWN SPOKE TO 5 22 HAD REPORTED THAT \$.2 HAD PLUGGED IN A CLOTHES DRYER FOR TENANTS TO USE AND IMMEDIATELY SAW ARCING, SPARKS, AND FLAMES. S.2 UNPLUGGED IT FROM THE WALL AND LEFT TO GET A FIRE EXTINGUISHER WITH THE DOOR CLOSING BEHINDS.22 S. RETURNED AND DISCHARGED THE EXTINGUISHER IN AND UNDER THE DRYER THAT HAD JUST BEEN ARCING. AFTER \$ 22 FULLY DISCHARGED THE EXTINGUISHER \$. DEPARTED THE LAUNDRY ROOM WITH THE DOOR CLOSING BEHIND \$.22
