Hello Minister,

I hope this finds you well. I followed Todd Stone's questioning of you during Question Period today regarding the cancellation of the Massey bridge procurement. The former minister had a less-than-desirable record in running the Transportation Ministry from a variety of perspectives, including the deliberate obstruction of the public's right to know the costs and contracting details of major projects. There is mounting evidence of systemic waste and/or corruption in the Transportation Ministry.

I was, however, dumbfounded when you said that you cannot provide bid information. There is no basis in law for that statement. As a former journalist, I hope you can be sympathetic for the public's right to know.

Further, you said: "On this side of the house, we care about public spending..." I am hoping you will put those words into action.

I want to bring to your attention an important decision three years ago by the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner, which ordered the release of information about bidders and bids on a City of Vancouver contract.

A link to that decision and a summary are below.

Minister, the previous government released the names of the three groups that were bidding for the Massey bridge project. One of those groups includes SNC-Lavalin, a company that has a horrendous record of corruption around the world. When you announced the cancellation, you said there would be two groups that would receive the \$2 million each in compensation.

There is no basis in law for withholding the names of the two bid groups that are receiving that compensation. I will vigorously defend my right to access that information and it would be poor optics for the NDP, which promised transparency, to resist disclosure.

I am asking for you to please provide me the names of the two bid groups that are receiving compensation for cancellation of the Massey bridge procurement.
