Mr. Pickering,

Thanks for the opportunity to address this issue that was forwarded to your attention.

Let me start by first addressing s.22 claim that Greyhound arbitrarily cancelled the s.22
s.22 on May 19 that he had a ticket for is incorrect and unfounded. Additionally, his accusation that Greyhound is

operating outside of our license and that sanctions should be imposed on Greyhound is not only incorrect, but also reckless.

s.22 : claims that he was refused entry to a bus trip that he had a ticket for, however that is not the case. s.22
s.22 stated that at 18:20 he attempted to board a bus that he assumed was for his trip and was refused entry by the Operator who told him the bus was not going s.22. The Operators alleged rude behavior aside, this was not the bus for Trip s.22 and the Operator was correct to refuse entry to s.22 for that reason.

In fact, s.22 - an hour later than the scheduled departure time. The delay in departure time was due to a previous delay on a connecting trip from Southeast BC due to the mudslide 30 kilometers west of Creston which forced that trip to detour and be delayed. So, the trip that s.22 had a ticket for was not cancelled, it did operate (albeit late), and it operates regularly as per our published schedules. I have verified through the Operator's log book that day of the timing of the trip and that it did make the required stop in s.22

You should be aware that s.22 also filed a Better Business Bureau complaint with the same verbiage as the PTB complaint and I have responded to that complaint as well. In his BBB submission, his desired resolution was for his bus ticket to be refunded in the requested amount of \$24.57 and an explanation of why his trip was cancelled. I have processed and mailed a refund in the requested amount to s.22 today and provided the same explanation that you have received above to him in the BBB response.

I trust that this will close this matter to your satisfaction however if you require more information or have further questions, please don't hesitate to contact me at your convenience.

The following complaint was received at the Branch (note the complaint has been edited for clarity):

Subject: I am writing this letter regarding the arbitrarily cancellation of the s.22 on May 19th. Apart from the rude and aggressive behavior by the driver, no explanation was offered. Clearly Greyhound is operating outside of its licence and I request sanctions be imposed. I had booked a ticket online, reference s.22 to travel s.22 s.22 May 19, s.22 bus. At 6:20 pm the bus arrived and I attempted to board. The bus driver, a rude, belligerent man refused my access telling me, "This is the end of the route for this bus" When I explained I had a ticket, he told me he didn't care and this bus was NOT going to s.22 I realize Greyhound has closed many routes in BC, and this appears to be utter ineptitude on the part of your staff . Subsequent discussions with Samantha Oliver of the Penticton Depot on Sunday, demonstrated she could care less about the bus not going to s.22 "I wasn't here yesterday" was her response.

The Branch is concerned with the reliability of this route, availability of service for ticketed passengers and the response from staff. Please investigate this incident and reply including by June 13, 2018.

Re: Greyhound Canada Transportation ULC – Discontinuances of intercity Bus Service in British Columbia

Dear Ms. Vanderkuip, Mr. Haywood, Ms. Broocke and Mr. McGee,

We act as counsel for Greyhound Canada Transportation ULC ("**Greyhound**") and have been mandated to provide the following notice to you in your respective capacities as Registrar and Director of the Passenger Transportation Branch and as Director of the Passenger Transportation Board.

It is with much regret that Greyhound hereby advises of its intent to discontinue all intercity bus service in British Columbia as authorized by Passenger Transportation License number 70414 as issued in March 2, 2018. This discontinuance will be effective as of October 31, 2018, at 11:59 p.m. The company has been forced to take this regrettable action in light of the prospect of continuing dire losses from its operations in the Province of British Columbia despite the recent implementation of route reductions applied for in August 2017.

Despite best efforts over several years, ridership has dropped by 41% across the country since 2010 within a changing and increasingly challenging transportation environment. Please see enclosed spreadsheet with ridership data for all route points served in British Columbia (schedule 7) and Ridership and Revenue Statistics for the last five years in British Columbia (schedule 8).

Bus passenger transport has been challenged by many factors: declining ridership in rural communities; increased competition from subsidized national and inter-regional passenger

transportation services; the new entry of ultra-low-cost carriers such as Swoop by WestJet, regulatory constraints and increased car travel.

Given the complete cessation of operations by the company in all of Western Canada as of that date, termination notices prescribed by the Canada Labour Code have been sent out to all employees in the province, advising of their termination effective October 31, 2018 at 11:59 p.m.

Greyhound's current license will expire on August 31, 2018. It is our understanding that the normal license renewal process is effected by the Registrar for a period of one year but that only the Board may vary the term of the renewed license under a decision issued by it pursuant to section 34(2) of the Act.

In these circumstances, pursuant to the terms of the Passenger Transportation Act, Greyhound hereby advises of its intention to apply to the Board for special authorization under section 26(1) and 28(2) of the Act for the renewal of its license for a specified term of 2 months from September 1, 2018 to October 31, 2018, inclusively pursuant to section 34(2) of the Act. Upon the expiry of the specified term the company will allow the license to lapse. At that time, Greyhound will return all identifiers and all vehicle identification certificates to the Registrar pursuant to section 45 of the Act and section 19 of the Regulation.

You will find herewith enclosed the application form and various annexes addressed to the Registrar and the Board requesting the renewal of Greyhound's license #70414 for a specified term of 2 months, to expire on October 31, 2018.

Please note that Greyhound requires 70 identifiers (decals) for Special Authorization Renewal for a period of two months from September 1, 2018 to October 31, 2018 inclusively for the vehicles described in the attached list (schedule 4).

Please note that as in the past, all vehicles are operated by Greyhound in British Columbia are PRP plated in Alberta and the registration fees are apportioned to British Columbia accordingly.

Should either the Board or the Registrar require that notices be posted or that Greyhound attend any Board hearings, it will comply with such directives and cooperate in any way with the Board and the Registrar.

However, due to the scale of discontinuance of service in all of Western Canada and the requirements of the Canada Labour Code for the issuance of termination notices to employees as well as the termination of multiple agreements with third party suppliers related to the delivery of the company's services, it will not be possible for the company to provide any bus service in the province beyond October 31, 2018.

We look forward to working together with Branch and the Board to effect the necessary actions to ensure the timely implementation of this sad measure, in full respect of the rights and circumstances of employees and of the travelling public.

Please note that the information contained in this letter should be treated as confidential and under embargo until 2:30 p.m. EST today, July 9, 2018, when a press release will be issued.

Employee notification will occur during this period and your cooperation is appreciated.

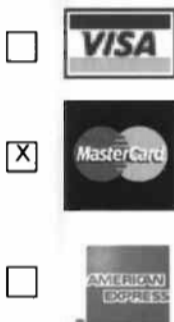

EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 31, 2018 OPERATIONS WILL DISCONTINUE IN ALL PROVINCES EXCEPT ONTARIO AND QUEBEC, CANADA-US ROUTES WILL CONTINUE

TORONTO, Ontario (July 9, 2018) -- Greyhound Canada has taken the difficult decision to downsize its operations. The company has notified all proper authorities of its intention to discontinue service – both passenger and freight -- effective October 31, 2018 in the provinces of Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba. In British Columbia, all routes will cease except for Vancouver to Seattle, which is operated by Greyhound Lines, Inc. (USA) and BoltBus.

All routes in Ontario and Quebec will continue unchanged, aside from the Trans-Canada service west of Sudbury in northern Ontario, which we will exit.

Greyhound Canada will continue to serve the following corridors:

- Toronto-Ottawa-Montreal-New York
- Toronto-Niagara Falls-Buffalo-New York
- Toronto-London-Windsor-Detroit
- Toronto-Barrie, Toronto-Guelph/Kitchener/Cambridge, and all other southern Ontario services.

Decision Rationale

This decision is regrettable and is due to a challenging transportation environment that is characterized by declining ridership in rural communities; increased competition from subsidized national and inter-regional passenger transportation services; the new entry of ultra-low-cost carriers; regulatory constraints, and increased car travel. Greyhound envisions that these changes will result in a viable, sustainable business on the remaining routes.

Greyhound Canada had taken a range of cost reduction steps over the last few years, including frequency adjustments to route schedules and other efficiency measures. Unfortunately, these actions were insufficient and the downward trajectory continued.

"It is with a heavy heart that we announce these service impacts for the end of October. We understand that these route changes are difficult for our customers. Despite best efforts over several years, ridership has dropped nearly 41% across the country since 2010 within a changing and increasingly challenging transportation environment. Simply put, we can no longer operate unsustainable routes."

"We are committed to keeping customers informed and will continue to provide fair and open communications to ensure that adequate notice is given."

Important to note: it is business as usual until October 31, 2018 — Greyhound Canada's operations will continue during the summer period and beyond Thanksgiving.

Route Changes and Route Retention

Effective October 31, 2018 the route information is as follows:

- British Columbia – discontinue all routes. Note: Service between Vancouver and Seattle, which is operated by Greyhound Lines, Inc. (USA) and BoltBus, is unaffected.
- Alberta – discontinue all routes
- Saskatchewan – discontinue all routes
- Manitoba – discontinue all routes
- Ontario - In Ontario, we will operate substantially as we do today in the southern and eastern regions of the province with no changes in the Toronto and Ottawa areas. There will be changes in the northern part of the province. Service will be discontinued on the Trans-Canada Highway, west of Sudbury. Greyhound Canada will continue to operate in southern Ontario ([click here to view Southern Ontario map](#)).
- Quebec - In Quebec there are no changes, with service between Ottawa and Montreal unaffected. Service between Montreal and New York that is operated by Greyhound Lines, Inc. (USA) is also unaffected.

Greyhound Canada is continuing its discussions with provincial and federal governments about the importance of government investments in rural connectivity.




