I would like to take a moment to say thank you for all your hard work, as well as that from the entire team, to have Highway 97 reopened as soon as it is safe to do so. I know a task of this magnitude requires a complete team effort, and that rock blasters and scalers, geotechnical engineers, traffic control personnel and many others including the maintenance contractor are not only working on an unstable rock fall, but are doing it day and night, during freezing cold conditions.

I appreciate the work you're doing, and understand the toll this is taking. Maintaining safe highways for the people of B.C. is crucial, and we are all lucky to have such dedicated professionals taking care of us.

2 Broader note to ministry:

On Thursday, January 31, a significant rock slide occurred on Highway 97 north of Summerland. While the road initially remained open to two lanes of traffic, more rocks and debris came down over the next two days, completely closing the highway. This was a big rock fall event, with nearly 6,000 cubic metres of rock and debris coming down - that's more than enough to fill two Olympic-sized swimming pools! The highway has now been fully closed for five days, and the site remains too unstable to safely remove the rock and get traffic moving again.

I would like to take a moment to thank all the people that are doing everything they can to have the highway reopened as soon as it is safe to do so. This includes the maintenance contractor, rock blasters and scalers, geotechnical engineers, traffic control personnel and many others. Not only are they working on an unstable rock fall, but they are doing it day and night, during freezing cold conditions.

While they may feel like this is a "thankless job", that's definitely not the case for myself and the rest of the staff at the ministry. We appreciate the work you're doing, and understand the toll this is taking. Rock scaling and blasting are treacherous jobs at the best of times, but with a slide of this nature, these workers are really going above and beyond.

Maintaining safe highways for the people of B.C. is crucial, and we are all lucky to have such dedicated professionals taking care of us.

- Safety is our top priority, and we will have the road reopened as soon as it is safe to do so.
- Drilling and blasting has occurred at the site over the past few days and continues today.
- This is a very complex and active rockfall site and geotechnical experts remain on site trying to stabilize the slope to allow for the safe reopening of the highway.
- There are currently 10 rock scalers, a rock hammer and 2 excavators on site, along with off highway rock trucks hauling material off site following the blasts.
- The ministry will be determining road opening options based on the progress that is made today.
- An alternate route for light vehicles (5 tons or less) is available on the 201 Forest Service Road, which is accessed off Highway 33 near McCulloch Road in Kelowna, and via Warren Avenue/Carmi Avenue in Penticton.
- The road is in good driving condition. Road maintenance vehicles will be actively working on the 201 Forest Service Road to ensure continued safe road conditions.
- Drivers using this route can expect up to an additional 90 minutes travel time. The speed limit along the 201 Forest Service Road is 50 km/h, and people must drive with caution along this route, which does not typically experience a high volume of traffic.
- Travel using other alternate unmaintained routes is not recommended and is being discouraged for safety reasons.
- Larger vehicles and commercial trucks must detour via Highway 97C, Highway SA and Highway 3A to Highway 3.

A report from the bureau says the provincial government committee reviewing transportation services should level the playing field for taxis and ridehailing providers.

Proposed response:

People have been asking for new ride-hailing services in British Columbia for seven years, however the former government failed to act. That's why during the last session, we passed legislation that will enable ride-hailing services in the province. Companies will be able to apply to enter the market by this fall.

It is important that the regulations are created in a way that ensures the safety of British Columbians, and prevents significant growth in congestion like that experienced in other jurisdictions which have introduced ride-hailing, like New York and San Francisco. These are top priorities that must be considered to get this right for people.

The committee will present recommendations after hearing from a wide range of experts, including input received by the Competition Bureau. I look forward to receiving their report by March 31st.
