#### Deborah,

Heads up to the government that yesterday's storm did considerable damage to the dock and marine infrastructure at Penelakut. We are on water taxi service to the island. Initial indicators are not good that this may require some significant effort to repair/rebuild the dock to make it safe. This will not be a quick fix and have some considerable impact on the community of Penelakut. I will send out more info as better technical becomes available over the coming days but we could be looking at weeks if not longer.

I will update the community through the FAC's. We are exploring all alternate possible services and soon as we know more we will advise. We will continue with water taxi and keep the service running that way as best we can while alternates are explored.

Continued steady progress today assisting BC Hydro with re-stablishing power and opening roads on the gulf islands, attached map shows progress.

Down to 8,006 customers without power today, 6,454 customers brought online within the last 24hrs. MC can now do road cleanup independent of BC Hydro (to this point each MC crew had to work closely with a Hydro crew to ensure safety of their workers during road cleanup due to downed lines) so can now ramp up resources.

Crews are working a full shift today and will continue working through the rest of the week.

Will continue to work with CRD to provide any assistance as required.

Next update will be tomorrow afternoon after the 1PM Operations Centre update.
