## Proposed response:

- The Vancouver Taxi Association (VTA) has informed the Passenger Transportation Branch that it recently entered an agreement with Kater to use its app-based technology in some taxis in the Lower Mainland.
- The Ministry, through the Passenger Transportation Branch, is taking steps to ensure that all
  current provincial and licensing requirements are met including a regular, government
  approved safety inspection of the vehicles, insurance that will cover the carrying of paying
  passengers and compliance with licence boundaries and other requirements until the fall of
  2019 when new regulations will come into force that will allow ride-hailing companies to enter
  the market.
- Between October 2018 and December 2018, the Passenger Transportation Board, an independent tribunal, approved additional taxis to operate in Metro Vancouver.
