Reporter is working on a story about understanding the traffic landscape in the Lower Mainland, "and seeing if there are creative ways to utilize data streams that already exist to connect commuters with better information (which hopefully makes commutes more bearable.)"

Primarily, he's hoping for data on the following major routes:

- Highway 99 from King George to downtown Vancouver
- Highway 1 from Horseshoe Bay to the Port Mann Bridge
- Lions Gate Bridge
- Iron Workers Memorial Bridge

DATA REPORTER IS SEEKING:

- 1. Traffic pattern information for major routes in the Lower Mainland over time and during specific time windows (example: weekend traffic patterns, vs. weekday patterns)
- 2. What data, such as drive time data from the RTMC, live traffic cameras or other data collecting and reporting infrastructure, could be utilized for real-time information?

Background

Recommendation

The ministry's Regional Transportation Management Centre is a 24-7 service providing real-time monitoring of road and traffic conditions. It's equipped with more than 200 live-streaming video feeds and 600 cameras. The information gathered from these sources allows staff to provide travel information on DriveBC and alert travellers by broadcasting this information on overhead Digital Messaging Signs (DMS).

Anyone can view the DMS information using the map view on www.drivebc.ca. In the legend, click the box next to Dynamic Message Sign. Then click the "DMS" symbol on the map, which will open a window showing the latest information.

Note that the Lions Gate Bridge Advanced Traveller Information System has a separate

The ministry is currently installing another network of dynamic message signs to provide real-time information about crossing times for the Alex Fraser Bridge and other Fraser River bridges. For more details, visit:

Traffic pattern information is available via this link: http://www.th.gov.bc.ca/trafficData/index.html. To access the data and run reports, under "Featured Topics" click on Highway Traffic Data, and then go the map and zoom in on a highway. Red dots are permanent count stations, and green dots are short counts, usually every 3 years. Click on a red dot, then in the left margin under "2004 – Present Traffic Data" you'll see what looks like a piece of paper on the left side. Click on that to get a quick summary .pdf report. At the bottom of the margin you can click on "more reports" if you want to zero in on a particular month or day, etc. and generate excel spreadsheets. A: Little Fort and Terrace ferries have been in service since 1912. The Lytton ferry has been operating since 1867. We do not have data available on the Jesmond ferry.

Q: Does the future for the McLure ferry look stable?

A: Yes, we look forward to many more years of service with this ferry.

Q: Is there any likelihood that the province may see an increase in the reaction ferry usage or creation of more?

A: At this time, there is no plan in place for this.

A: In 2017/18, the ferry transported approximately 18,000 vehicles and 32,000 passengers.

Q: Can you tell me anything additional about the McLure ferry?

A: McLure Ferry service began in April 1919 in an effort to provide ranchers and farmers on the west side of the North Tompson River with access to the main road to Kamloops. As well, it gave these residents access to McLure Station on the Canadian Northern Pacific Railway (now Canadian National) and to a store, and post office. Upon establishment, the crossing was known as the Fishtrap Ferry.

QUESTION:

- Reporter says: I see that last year, British Columbia reduced speed limit on 570 kms of road. Can you tell me what the reasons were behind this decision?

Background

Recommendation

- People need to feel safe on our roads, and we are always looking for ways to make travel safer.
- In 2014 speed limits were raised on 33 highway segments. After reviewing three years of data, we determined that some of those highway segments experienced an increase in crashes and closures.
- That's why in November 2018, we rolled back speed limits by 10 km/h on 15 corridors, covering almost 570 kilometres – taking every precaution to make our roads safer.
- There were 16 other highway segments that did not see a reduction in safety for these, including the Coquihalla, speed limits remained the same.
- Speed is only one of a number of factors that cause crashes. Changing weather conditions, distracted driving, driving too fast for conditions, heavy traffic, falling asleep at the wheel, alcohol, driver error and wild animals can all contribute to crashes.
- We will always take a reasonable and measured approach to speed limit changes based on the data – to make sure that the speed limits on our highways are as safe for people as possible.

- While this is a minor slide, it has taken place in the same location as the larger slide which occurred in late
 February, causing an extended highway closure.
- The ministry has planned rock fall mitigation improvements on this section, and this work to improve safety is

- Work will include the installation of rock bolts, drains, slope mesh and a small amount of scaling.

Reporter writes:

Just inquiring about the bid opportunity posted by the MoT Friday about 10 Mile Slide. Just had a few questions about the scope of the project, how much is allocated and if this bid is seeking the "be all end all" fix to the problem. From my understanding, that area has been a problem for some time and vehicle weight restrictions have been in place for the unstable portion.

Background

Recommendation

- The tender has been issued for the main stabilization work required at the 10 Mile Slide location.
- This work will provide a long-term solution on one of B.C.'s most technically challenging slide sites, approximately 17 kilometres northeast of Lillooet.
- Initial soil anchor installation, widening, grading and drainage improvements to the highway were completed in
 early 2019, and following extensive geotechnical assessments, the load restrictions were increased to 27,000
 kilograms GVW. While this load restriction remains in place, it is subject to change on short notice, should site
 conditions deteriorate.
- The active slide surrounds Highway 99, which is vital to the local and regional economy as the primary connector between Lillooet and Kamloops.
- The area has experienced ongoing slide activity for several decades, severely affecting the Xaxli'p community, local businesses, the trucking and tourism industries, and the general public.
- The Province is investing approximately \$60 million in this stabilization project, which will result in a reliable, permanent two-lane paved roadway once completed, improving safety for people travelling along this section of Highway 99.
- Work is expected to begin this summer and be completed in fall 2020.




