A quick summary below.

- There was some damage to^{S.22} property related to the Williams Lake to Lexington 4-laning project in Williams Lake.
- The cause is not fully determined, but we do acknowledge that it did result from some design issues and/or the delays associated with the fires in the area in 2017/18.
- The Claim process is the only mechanism that we have to make a payment of this size
- We will have our project team work through the claim application process with him so that we can start a
 file. Concurrently, we will be drafting up the settlement offer of \$100,000.
- We should be able to resolve this in fairly short order, but just need to take these steps to meet our financial obligations.
- Todd Hubner updated the MLA yesterday as well during a conversation on a different topic.

How many projects currently fall under CBA? (Reporter heard 4, but found TransCanada four-laning, Pattullo Bridge and Broadway Subway)

- Current projects under the CBA include:
 - o The Trans-Canada Highway 1 Kamloops to Alberta Four-Laning Project;
 - o the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project and;
 - o the Broadway Subway Project

How far along in the process are each of these individual projects? (How close to hiring the workers that benefit from CBA?)

- The first section of the Highway 1 Four-Laning Project: Illecillewaet, has been awarded to Emil Anderson Construction through a fair and open bidding process. Work will start in the coming weeks, and the project should be completed in 2021. BCIB will be hiring its first workers shortly.
- Proponents for the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project have been shortlisted and are putting together their bids. The contract will be awarded to the preferred proponent in fall 2019. Early construction is expected to start in spring 2020, and the new crossing will open to traffic in 2023. BCIB will be starting recruitment and outreach for the project's workforce later in fall 2019.
- Proponents for the Broadway Subway Project have been shortlisted. The Province expects to select the
 preferred proponent by mid-2020. You can find more information about the project here:
